

2020 Democratic Primary Fantasy League

Instructions:

Think about who you want to win the 2020 Democratic Primary. Now think about who you *think* will win the primary. Who will drop out and when? If you need help thinking of candidates look below, I've taken the list from ballotopedia.org and added them for easy reference.

Once you have a good idea about who you want to hedge your bets with, start filling out [the bracket](#) in a manner comfortable for you. You can print a copy and submit it in writing if you want, or I can create a tab under which your choices can be made and changed. You should know, every change you make can be viewed in the google edits history, by me.

- "Ranking" for each state refers to the top three vote winners in order of votes received.
- "Drop Out" for each state refers to candidates expected to drop out, and in what order.
- To add a pick, simply add the first initial/last name to the appropriate box.
- Additionally, leaving MOST categories blank will not hurt you. A wrong selection in Wild Card Choices, WILL count against you as a negative point value.
- "Super Tuesday" refers to the day with the most primaries occurring together.
- "Tuper Tuesday" refers to the day with the second most primaries occurring together.

Rules:

1. Primary choices must be submitted before 11:59:59 PM EST of the day before the primary for each state.
2. Party Candidate and Running Mate must be chosen no later than 11:59:59 PM EST May 1st, 2020.
3. Winning picks for Super Tuesday and Tuper Tuesday are based on who one the most votes overall. Winning picks are not calculated based on best performance across states or whatever.
4. Wild Card choices must be made prior to March 1st, 11:59:59 PM, EST.
5. Electoral College - Just choose how many members of the electoral college you believe will go to the Democrat, and how many you think will go to the unindicted co-conspirator for a possible 3 points.
