The jury may hear all or part of a second aria chosen from list prepared by the candidates.

From the Renaissance to the Classical period. A dramatically compelling concept for the submitted program is highly welcome. The program, accompanied by a short written introduction, should be presented at the final on August 12th.

The competition entry in the final must not last longer than 15 minutes.

A harpsichord (two manuals, 415/440 Hz) will be available for the competition. Participants may bring their own keyboard instruments by prior arrangement.

Since the Renaissance, music has been a major concern of the rulers of the Principality of Palatinate-Neuburg; they repeatedly brought the most important musicians of their time to the court. The violin virtuoso Biagio Marini, who comes from Brescia (Italy), worked as court music director in the service of the Count Palatine for almost 30 years. Today Biagio Marini is considered one of the first important composers of instrumental music, who had a significant influence on Italian music of the 17th century.

The international early music competition of the same name, which

has been held annually in Neuburg an der Donau since 1999, is a reminder of this illustrious time in music cultivation. As the only permanent competition for early music in Bavaria, the Biagio Marini Competition is aimed at young chamber music groups who are committed to historical performance practice and play on historical instruments.
