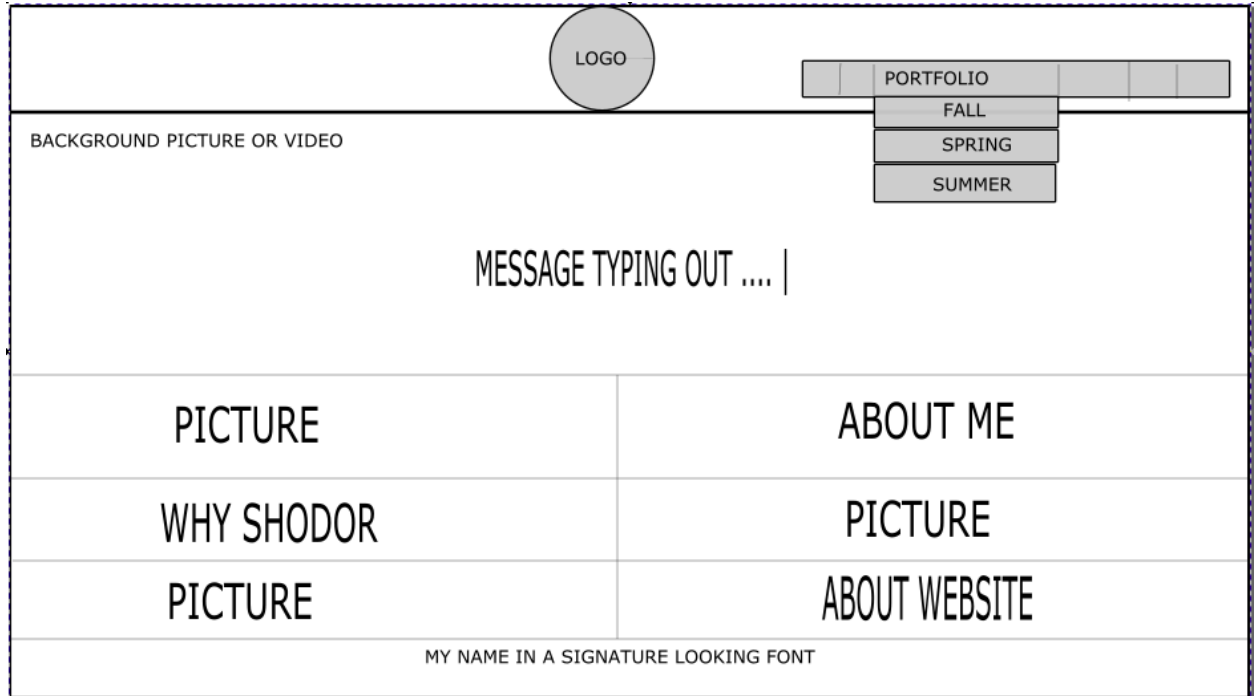


1. What is your website about? **done**
