Good Afternoon. On Tuesday March 9, 2020, CHS 11th grade students have the opportunity to take the ACT at Carbon High School. This year will look different than previous years as students will be testing on their Chromebooks instead of paper/pencil. We will be using many of the classrooms in A and B hall for testing during the morning hours.

The buses will run on a normal schedule for the day. While juniors are the only students required to come in the morning, any student who needs the bus to get to school in morning should ride the bus as normal. We will have classrooms and teachers available for non juniors to work on assignments or other activities. Any non-junior who does not need the bus, or rides in with a junior, does not need to arrive until lunch (if they eat school lunch) or at the end of lunch.

On March 9th, juniors will come to school in the morning. Check in for the test will begin at 7:45 AM and we hope to be started at 8:15 AM (this is a 3+ hour test). Teachers will have an assignment (proctoring in the test room, supervising hallways, etc.). The exam will end close to noon. 9th, 10th, and 12th grade students will come at noon for lunch and then there will be an abbreviated 5 period schedule for the rest of the afternoon. juniors can go to class if they want to, but they will be excused after the ACT. Any juniors who need to ride the bus home at the end of the day should plan to attend classes in the afternoon. The buses will run at their normal schedule after school.
