- **Directorships and Stakes:** In many family-run businesses in India, spouses often hold stakes or board positions. While Jay was a director at **Temple Enterprise** and holds a majority stake in **Kusum Finserve**, the broader family ecosystem (including the business interests of the Patels) suggests a collaborative approach to wealth management within their social circle.
