Filming Options for Creating a Video

- You can use your phone or filming software provided on your device (Quicktime, Vimeo etc.)
- [Zoom](#) also offers options for recording
- You are welcome to explore other video/screen recording software you may already subscribe to (Loom, Screencastify, etc.)

Generating a Link for your Videos

Here are a few ways we recommend to create and share a link to your video. Please note the below tutorial videos for extra support.

1. Google Drive
 - a. [How to Share a Video on Google Drive](#)
 - b. Important: For this method, be sure to check your video has shared permissions with your instructor.
2. Dropbox
 - a. [How To Create A Shareable Link In Dropbox - Dropbox Tutorial](#)
3. iCloud Link
 - a. In Photos on iCloud.com, select the photos or videos you want to share.
 - b. Click the Share button, then choose Copy Link, then click Copy Link. You can paste the link into the PDF provided. (Keyboard shortcuts: ctrl(command on mac) + c for copy and ctrl (command on mac) + v for paste).
4. Zoom

Video Requirements

- Please only submit 1 video link per video
 - Submit/Share the link to: brynnecaleda@gmail.com
- Title Your Videos
 - First Initial, Last Name Mihi Video (for example: B.Kuch Mihi Video)
- Your video is not to exceed 3 minutes in length

Signing Up for a Free Account With Loom

1. Visit <https://www.loom.com/signup> to sign up for a free account.
2. Please note, when you sign up for a free account, you are automatically given a “pro” trial that will expire. Should you receive the following message, know that your account will remain active (free version) even after this expiration, and you are not required in any way to purchase a continuation of this product or ANY video recording programs for this course.

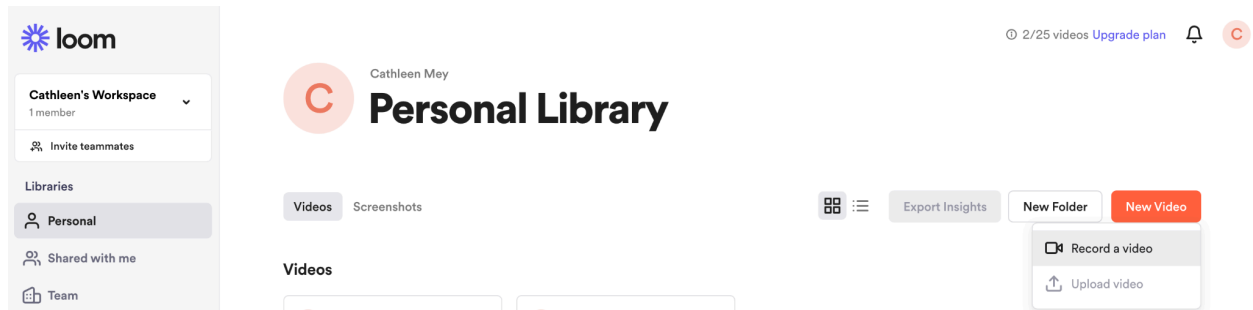

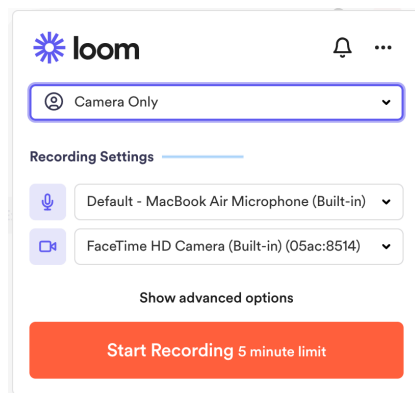
3. Loom is a great option for videos kept less than 5 min total. If you choose to not use Loom, we highly recommend using one of the aforementioned options, such as Zoom, Google Drive, or iCloud.
4. Below you will find more detailed instructions for Loom setup and usage.




Using Loom:

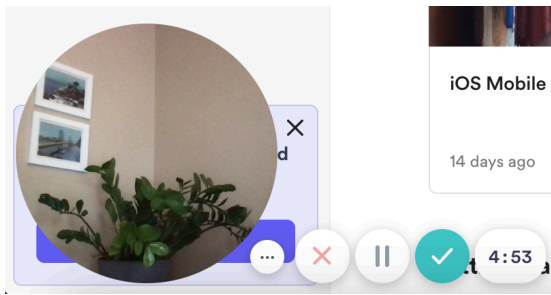
1. Choose a Loom recording platform to install:
 - a. [Loom Chrome Extension](#)
 - b. [Loom Desktop App for Macs or PCs](#)
 - c. [Loom for iOS \(iPhone or iPad\)](#)
 - d. [Loom for Android](#)
2. Click the New Video button and select Record a video.



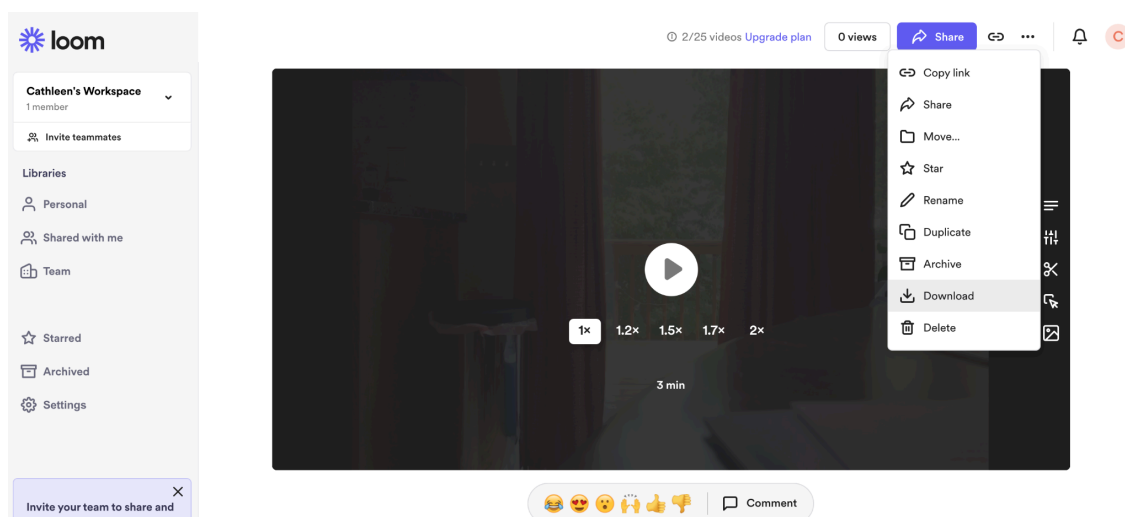
3. For the purposes of these videos, CHOOSE the “Camera Only” option when recording. Click the Start Recording button to begin recording your video.



4. You will see a countdown on the screen, then the camera will begin recording. To the right of the image being recorded, you will have the following options:
 - a. The  will cancel the recording
 - b. The  will pause the recording
 - c. The  will finish the recording



5. Try to stay within the recommended time limits for the assignment (3 minutes or less) to ensure the video file size is within 100 MB.
6. After recording a video, you can Share the link by clicking the Share button and selecting Share.
