Participant Responsibilities

I agree to:

 - Behave respectfully towards other participants.
 - Not consume illegal drugs.
 - Not consume excessive alcohol during the tour.
 - Respect wildlife and the natural environment.
 - Follow Leave No Trace principles.
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Participant Insurance
