Woman makes history at town meeting

The National Democratic Party can have Geraldine Ferraro—Wake Forest is also making history with women in politics.

At a special meeting Thursday, Town Commissioner Kenille Prosser made town history when she became the first woman to preside over a town board meeting.

Elected to her first term as commissioner in 1981, Prosser was elected mayor pro-tem this year by her fellow commissioners, all men.

Since Mayor Tommy Byrne was in Southern Pines and was unable to attend Thursday's meeting, Prosset took over, and with polite authority. When residents at the meeting began asking to speak about an issue at hand, Prosser politely said the public hearing had already been held and opened the floor for a motion from the commissioners.

Wake Forest has had two other female commissioners, Dessie Harper and Ailey M. Young, who served in the 1970's.

Impressions from other family members

Cousin Dennis

I'm not sure, but I think it was the first grade that I met my cousin Kenille. I specifically remember I must have done something wrong in class, because my cousin, who attended school with me one day, promptly told my mother about it when we got home from school. Funny what we remember.

There are three events in particular, cousin Kenille's wedding, an international Baumgardner reunion in Colorado and another family wedding in Baltimore that highlight my other memories of the Kenneth Baumgardner family. First, Kenille's wedding. Another cousin, Dr. George's son John, and I journeyed to Gainesville, Georgia. It was quite a memorable occasion. It was a large grand event. Cousin John and I actually stayed in a college dorm on the campus at Brenau University. For some reason, I went grocery shopping with cousin Kenille and her mother aunt Elizabeth. While in the grocery store, I decided to light up a cigarette. That proved to truly be a big mistake. Aunt Elizabeth immediately began to scorn me for harming myself and others in the store because of the smoking. She was really ahead of her time. I don't think any of the anti-smoking campaign had begun yet. As to the wedding, it was quite the event. Just prior to that day, a bachelor party was held in an unusual establishment. I

recall the walls were so created to have you feel like being in a cave. I think it may have been part of a country club? Back to the wedding, the music was untraditional. I believe a classmate of cousin Kenille's had written several fugues for the ceremony. As I remembered, he also had a big crush on my cousin?

Dennis, (Kenille here) this saga could go on and on because all the music for my wedding was written by this man and since he was also the organist, he had handwritten the music so only he could really read it. During the party on the eve of the wedding Cousin John and he seemed to be arguing in German when suddenly my organist ran out of the room and out to the lake threatening to throw himself into the lake (due to this crush). My organist left early the next morning saying he could not watch me get married to another man, but he did leave his original music behind. Don't remember who or how we found a substitute organist, but I know he had also written a solo piece for my father to sing and a trio for my brother, father, and another male voice. Daddy cried through much of his singing and then my sister threw up during the communion part of the wedding because she had had too much to drink the night before. I guess after this beginning of my marriage, I should be glad that it lasted as long as it did.

Cousin John

Uncle Ken's family moved to Maryland during the summer of 1961. The last time I had seen Kenille since she was a little girl. At this time she was a pretty young woman and I remembered thinking myself unfortunate to be closely related and not a suitor. However, two of my friends did not suffer this disadvantage. My neighbor and best friend Philip Mohr and my McDonogh School roommate Gary Crowell both fell hard for Kenille. My cousin was a femme fatale. I also recall that she was my passenger during both of my early M.V.A.'s, a case of distracted driving I guess.
