Privacy Policy for Shopify App Debugger

1. Introduction

The Shopify App Debugger Chrome extension is designed to help Shopify store owners and developers debug Shopify apps and detect potential theme conflicts. This Privacy Policy explains what information we collect and how we use it.

2. Information We Do Not Collect

Our extension does not collect, store, or share any personal information. Specifically, we do not collect:

Personally identifiable information (e.g., name, address, email)

Health information

Financial or payment information

Authentication information (e.g., passwords)

Personal communications (e.g., emails, texts)

Location data (e.g., IP addresses, GPS)

Web history (e.g., browsing activity)

User activity (e.g., clicks, keystrokes)

Website content (e.g., images, videos)

3. Information We Access

The extension temporarily accesses information on the current Shopify storefront page to:

Detect installed apps by analyzing script tags.

Check for theme conflicts or modifications.

Measure script performance for optimization purposes.

This information is processed locally on the user's device and is not transmitted or stored outside the browser.

4. Permissions Justification

activeTab: To scan the current Shopify storefront page for apps and theme issues.

scripting: To execute diagnostic scripts on the current page for debugging purposes.

storage: To save user settings within the extension.

host_permissions: To operate on Shopify storefronts (*.myshopify.com).

5. Third-Party Services

This extension does not use third-party services or analytics tools.
