Mia: That's a strange picture, Luke. What are those men doing?

Luke: They're playing sepak takraw, Mia. It's a popular sport from Asia.

Mia: What's sepak takraw?

Luke: It's a combination of volleyball and football. Some people call it kick volleyball.

Mia: Volleyball and football in one game. Sounds interesting. Where do you play it?

Luke: You play it on a court with a net. The court can be inside or outside. There are two teams, one on each side of the net.

Mia: That sounds like volleyball. How many people can play it?

Luke: Each team must have three players on the court. Volleyball teams have got six players.

Mia: OK, so they've only got three players. What are the rules of the game? How do you win?

Luke: You must get the ball over the net.

Mia: Volleyball players hit the ball over the net, too.

Luke: Yes, but in sepak takraw, the players mustn't touch the ball with their hands or arms.

Mia: How can they play without using their hands?

Luke: That part is similar to football. They hit the ball with their head, back or legs. They also kick the ball over the net.

Mia: Wow! That must be difficult. Is the net high?

Luke: Yes, it is. They must jump up to kick the ball. It isn't easy.

Mia: I'm sure it isn't. Do you need any special equipment to play sepak takraw?

Luke: No, you don't. That's one of the great things about it. All you need is a ball and some good trainers. The game is popular in Europe now because it's good exercise and it's fun. I'm thinking of joining a sepak takraw team.

Mia: Well, have fun, Luke.

Luke: There's a team for girls, too. Why don't you join it, Mia?

Mia: No, thanks. I like sports, but sepak takraw sounds difficult.
