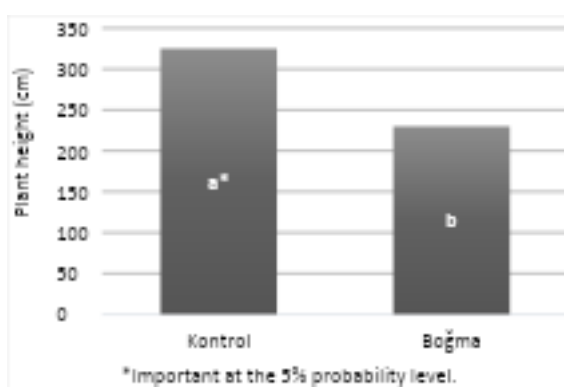


Figure 1. The effect of strangulation on plant height (cm)
