

Immunizations: Make sure your student is up to date to attend school

All enrolled students must be up to date on immunizations as required by Washington State. Fall seventh graders need a tdap booster administered after the age of 10 as part of the required vaccines. Don't delay scheduling an appointment with a medical provider before school starts on August 27.

Behind on vaccines? Please review the school requirements by grade level and contact your medical provider to ensure your student is eligible to attend this fall.

Vaccine Records

How do I obtain a copy of my student's immunization records?

- If you are a Washington state resident, you can download a copy of your child's immunization record on the [WA State Immunization Record website](#).
- You must register for an account and then log in. Go to "MyImmunizations" at the top of the page and then click the "Certificate of Immunization" button to download the pre-filled CIS and save to your computer.
