April 2026

During March, the team completed 21 change requests. By the way, an add takes about 1-½ to 2 hours.

We updated the Spanish meetings based on time zone (Mexico City CET, Argentina (ART), and Madrid (CET). They were loaded with local time zones, so they should change automatically as their time zone changes. This was incredibly complicated to do but we feel we have a solution that will work globally going forward.

We've updated Portuguese language meetings (Brazil) similarly.

We reviewed all of the Specific Focus pages to ensure that they used the correct reference for all Recovery meetings (since we added more Zoom rooms for DST).

The changes to oa.org's FIND A MEETING will drive more changes in our own forms. We assisted in the testing of the new oa.org features.



March 2026

We've been grappling with how best to handle **Daylight Savings Time**. [See here for details](#). Specific issues are meetings that stick to their non-DST time and end up bumping into other meetings. Meetings cannot just move up or back on hour on the regular Zoom room schedule because they will run into other meetings.

Here is the solution we are working on: we load all meetings of a specific language/ time zone in their own Zoom room. We load them into their own Zoom room with their their local time zone. It will still show in whatever time zone the viewer is in but it will advance/regress the meeting time on DST dates.

Digital Coordinator established additional Zoom rooms to accommodate these meetings. We also "took over" the 10B Committee room because it has not been used for months.

February 2026

This month, we've spent our committee time keeping up with the 30 meeting change requests we've received. We are down a few service workers and the three active maintenance service workers have used their two scheduled work sessions to keep up! We can use people interested in detail work involving updating three areas with correct meeting data!

We've also released notifications of Daylight Savings Time/Summer Time. We are working on a solution for those areas with no DST changes and also those who have weeks in between time changes.

January 2026

- Installed a page for Spanish-speaking meetings (thank you Olivier!)
- Implemented a new EVENT page, which shows colorful tiles for each event. This involved a new TeamUp calendar and collaboration with the "Fab Flyers" Canva team to establish a standard for placing a smaller flyer suitable for these tiles.
- Add Intergroup Meetings, Unity Day, secular/atheist workshop.
- We have received 21 meeting change this month

2025

★★★★★2025 ACCOMPLISHMENTS★★★★★

- **Defined an “intelligent” slot number on TeamUp. That is, the code for each time slot tells us the Zoom platform, day and time of the entry. This helps us catch time zone-related inconsistencies.**
- **Created a Combined spreadsheet which pulls together entries from different Google forms. This means that we can work with eight tabs on one spreadsheet instead of eight different spreadsheets.**
- **Reworked 27 Meeting Support web pages. This includes**
 - **“What to do if...” page**
 - **A Meeting Support page that contains a wealth of information and links for meetings. This info used to be sent out via email for new meetings; now it is available for everyone to see.**
 - **Best Practices pages that outline how to open and control, and close, a meeting.**
- **Updated the meetings schedule shown on the website - front and center on the landing page! Viewers can now select the type of meeting they are looking for: Recovery Meetings, Workshops, Committee/Intergroup, etc.**
- **Increased the number of fields on Foot Steps calendar entries (adding zoom link, telephone link, etc.) to clean up the description box and allow people to readily find the link.**
- **Increased Foot Steps diversity outreach by establishing Specific Focus and Specific Topic fields. This was paired with a selection that allows viewers to choose the meetings they are most interested in.**

- **Added 10 Arabic meetings!**
- **Defined a tracking number for each request we receive. In the past, we would refer to “the email received at a particular date and time”. Now we can reference “25-235” and know exactly what request we are dealing with. This change has really taken everyone’s blood pressure down a notch.**
- **We have handled 206 service requests since we began our advanced tracking system in March 2025. Adding a recurring recovery meeting takes as much as 1-½ hours, so these are lots of service hours**
 - **44 Email requests**
 - **35 Add a Meeting**
 - **42 Edit a Meeting**
 - **16 Delete a Meeting**
 - **17 Report a Problem**
 - **12 Ghosted Meetings**
 - **17 Edit Contacts**
 - **22 Add a One Time Meeting**
 - **1 Edit Specific Topic and Focus**

December 2025

- **Completed the process to merge Events and One Time meetings. This included updating the “Add a One Time Meeting” form, changing the “Add an Event” link, adding a 12D Events calendar (with no Zoom room), and changing the “Events” page to show TeamUp entries in large tile format. This enables the scheduling on TeamUp and the entry of events to be one and the same. The Committee has a process for handling new requests regularly, so Events are more likely to be addressed in a timely manner. Also, the new tiles can display flyers.**

- Rolled out form to edit Specific Topic and Focus
- We are in the process of loading 9 Arabic meetings! This has involved special training sessions and a great deal of work with meeting leaders. This is making OA available to an entire region of the world.
- We are scheduling extra time to address meeting requests (adds, edits, reported problems, etc) since we are down a person. We could really use the help to keep our files, Foot Steps schedule and oa.org up to date. We often work as a team to make updates and there is lots of documentation. November 2025

Event Handling

The process for events and one time meeting has been consolidated. Also, the [Events page](#) on our website

- Now references TeamUp events in “tile” format by using a new calendar 12D.
- Requirements to display an image on a tile have been identified.
- The Add a One Time Meeting form was changed to accommodate new events.
- Procedures defined to add an Event.

Arabic Meetings

Have begun loading the first few of 10 Arabic meetings. Hosts have attended special Security Classes to learn Zoom security.

Processed 38 requests for Meeting Additions/Changes/Deletes/Problem Resolution.

October 2025

Digital and Meeting Support Committee members formed a group to develop flyers in Canva after receiving several requests from meetings. There are 11 people in the WhatsApp group; they have been meeting weekly Tuesday at 4:00pm ET to develop flyers together in an environment of learning and sharing.

The committee began work to combine Events and one-time meetings. This will simplify our handling of these requests. We also developed a way for Events to be shown on the events calendar while not posting private events, such as sponsee meetings.

The committee continues work on meeting requests and changes, especially Arabic-speaking meetings.

APRIL 2025

We're planning to create a meeting view which allows the viewer to easily select a Specific Topic or Specific Focus. We are discussing ways to reach out to meeting contactss and ask them to update their meeting with these fields.

We are working on a way to manage the expectations of a meeting change request and to improve communication between us and submitter of the request. To that end, we are holding off updating OA.ORG until TeamUp and the Master Spreadsheet are updated and we have sent our email to the submitter.

Discussion of the Info Subcommittee to be under the Meeting Support Committee umbrella. We also have realized how important it is to keep the Info Subcommittee abreast of changes being made.

We have updated the TeamUp fields and standard formats and have begun updating existing meetings to bring tem up to standard. We have all of the 1A-Dark Blue and some of the 2A-Dark Purple zoom chambers updated. These hold the majority of our meetings.

MARCH 2025

We have created a COMBINED REQUEST spreadsheet which brings together all of the responses sent through all of our forms - Add, Edit, Delete, Edit Contact, Report, Ghost. Each entry is uniquely numbered so we can refer to "25-104" rather than "the request we got from M-Name on 3/25/2025 12:03:34". We enter comments in the leading three columns. Also, filters have been defined to hide closed requests.

All of the new Add-Edit-Delete forms were put into production.

TeamUp field changes are complete and the “new standardized format” for TeamUp entries has been completed. We want to encourage meetings to communicate their Specific Topic and Specific Focus on TeamUp before we make mass updates to the TeamUp calendar. Idea is to create a Canva flyer with QR code for EDIT A MEETING form.

FEBRUARY 2025

New Add-Edit-Delete forms were created and tested. Not yet in production. The logic of GDPR questions were changed to be more specific. Major change to [AED pages](#) is planned. This will also change the spreadsheets which we use to track requests.

Daylight Savings Time / Summer Time is behind us.

On TeamUp, LANGUAGE was added as a new field. This involved changing the license on TeamUp - increase was part of budget. Field only shows if you are in edit mode or if there is a value in the field.

Committee responsibilities shifted.

OA.ORG errors

We identified 97 OA.ORG meetings who have an incorrect link (requires password).

Daylight Savings Time/Summer Time

Meme prepared for distribution. US change is March 9; begin posting March 1.

JANUARY 2025

Non-Real Time meetings were cleaned up. Instead of listing the meetings both in the TeamUp event and on the webpage, we only list the meetings on the webpage. The TeamUp event links to the webpage.

Budget was increased by \$500 (\$720 was requested) to allow us to upgrade our TeamUp License. This will allow adding a field for language and for future growth.

Website - planning for new recovery meeting views. These views would filtered for all of the Specific Topic and Specific Focus values. We just learned how to create a link which includes filtered values.

Service Basics Workshop is the new name for our Intergroup Reb Basics Workshop. Sessions being scheduled every two weeks at times to accommodate various time zones globally.

New Email to Meeting Leaders was reviewed using more references to new webpages. This letter will form the basis for our Meeting Support page(s).

Cancelled meetings on OA.ORG will still show if the specific meeting number is entered. It will not show on the search meetings function.

What To Do If... was reviewed.

Removed the words OPEN/CLOSED from TeamUp values (only leave the description with/without visitors).

DECEMBER 2024

Began using instructional videos (yeah Dawn!).

Many website changes completed

- Let the TeamUp NRT entry point to the NRT page. Eliminates duplication of data. Questions about Body Image 1 and Body Image 2. Same Meeting?

Closed six meetings on TeamUp and OA.ORG per our guidelines. We need to update our process to reach out three times via email or whatsApp to leaders.

Committee Budget increased TeamUp fee from \$300 to \$720 to open up additional fields. We talked through ideas to “reuse” fields until all of the updates could be completed, but ended up with a leader’s name in the field labelled “Language”. Too complicated for us to do and too confusing for our viewers.

NOVEMBER 2024

TeamUp

- Tested the behaviour of TeamUp when changes made. Bottom line is that we continue to make changes as we have been, but need to carefully check past and future meetings for anomalies.
- COMMENT field behaving oddly - comments not carried forward. Cecilia to contact TeamUp.
- We have 49 meetings for which to update Specific Topic and Focus
- TeamUp Standardization. We want to combine custom fields to avoid an increase in license fees. In progress. Fields under discussion include
 - Eliminate OPEN/CLOSED. Put in Meeting Description.
 - **Combine Zoom ID and Password**
 - Eliminate contact email because it is inside the description,

- Continue to use “leader”? Need for committee reporting? Replace “Leader” with “Meeting Contact” and keep with in meeting description.

Meeting Changes

Dawn has taken on a full time job and Karen has stepped back from maintenance. We will change our approach like this:

- Add a second maintenance session every week. At these two meetings, Cecili and/or Dawn will be present to make changes while newer team members will attend as they can to learn. Cecilia to send out polls to find best time.

We are receiving Ghost Busters reports from the zoom admin’s form and following up on incidents. We enter items into our tracking spreadsheets

Committee Web Pages

We have had our new page content developed for a few months. Cecilia learned how to create Word Press pages and theDigital Team has updated the menu system to accommodate.

TeamUp

Implemented new views smoothly - no questions or comments. Now working on getting Available slots loaded. Next project will involve updating the contents of each TeamUp event to include Specific Topic, Specific Focus, custom fields for Zoom link and telephone link, and comments field (visible only to those with modify access)

IR Basics Workshop

Have given class twice. No attendees at first session; Four attendees at second session. Evaluation form was distributed. This brings up to total people who have gone through the workshop to 12.

Telephone Meetings

Foot Steps now includes telephone meetings! One meeting occurring six days/week.

Daylight Savings Time / Summer Time Changes

Clocks will be changing from October 6 to November 3. New memes designed and announcement verbiage composed.

Ghosting Meetings

Documentation / instructions prepared but no clear place to put it.

AUGUST 2024

TEAMUP

It was determined that up to two meetings could be held at the same time on most platforms. This eliminates the need to buy an additional license. It also affected our how our TeamUp calendars look.

We've established some standard language to use

- Zoom is a PLATFORM
- TeamUp calendars are ROOMS (1-BLUE, 2-PURPLE, etc)
- Each ROOM has two CHAMBERS which can hold one meeting each.
- So 1-BLUE room contains two chambers: 1A-DARK BLUE 1B-LIGHT BLUE
2-PURPLE room contains two chambers: 2A-DARK PURPLE 2B-LIGHT PURPLE

Development Plan

- Lisa is completing different views of the calendars (Recovery, Committee/Workshop, Available, All). The only existing page to change is the front page.
- Pages will be reviewed again with the Digital Committee
- At the same time, Meetings Sched Committee will update our MASTER to include all of the new information.

Go Live

- Cecilia will update TeamUp calendars to new names and colors

- Next, Lisa will update her filters and embed language and update the new TeamUp views.
- Next, we will update the front page. This will make all of the new TeamUp pages available.

Following Go Live:

- Add new AVAILABLE slots

SECURITY - MEETINGS EFFORT: Members of our committee met with the Security Committee to (1) update the email templates sent to leaders of new meetings and (2) construct a page summarizing security policies, resources etc to which meeting leaders can be directed. This review was completed, the revised email for new meetings template is changed and Security Committee will pursue getting updated page added to website.

IG REP BASICS WORKSHOP: This workshop has now been presented twice and will be scheduled at least once per month.

JULY 2024

The motion to remove CEM43 from our Policies and Procedures passed. This is what it means: currently we maintain a list of meetings (in our Brown platform) not in Foot Steps Intergroup as a courtesy to Young People’s Intergroup. Reasoning

- The Bylaws state that we are to “serve and represent the member groups”.
- Review of the meetings on our website showed we were missing three meetings and included one which no longer met.
- Maintaining Brown takes resources we could direct toward Foot Steps.

We are exploring ways to make it easier to support diversity by making it easy to view meetings which have indicated an identity with one of the Specific Focus entries.

TEAMUP: Many changes are in the works. The overview is

1. Implement the new TeamUp appearance with existing names (Lisa/Digital Cmte) see details in [Project Plan Rename TeamUp Calendars](#) IN PROCESS
2. Move ORANGE to RED (Karen and Dawn) IN PROCESS

- 3. Change names and implement new rooms
- 4. Add AVAILABLE for new rooms

WEBSITE UPDATES The proposed changes to website pages related to Meetings has moved forward and is now being discussed with the Digital Committee. First focus is on the display of TeamUp meetings as referenced above.

SECURITY - MEETINGS EFFORT: Members of our committee are meeting with the Security Committee to (1) update the email templates sent to leaders of new meetings and (2) construct a page summarizing security policies, resources etc to which meeting leaders can be directed.

IG REP BASICS WORKSHOP: This workshop has now been presented twice and can be considered open for anyone interested in learning more about service both globally and within Foot Steps.

CREATIVE REPRIEVE: A daily meeting was suspended for the summer.when hopefully leaders will be able to commit to serving the meeting.

JUNE 2024

TeamUp

We have a [plan in place](#) to add new zoom accounts, rename calendars and move ORANGE entries to RED. We will do it after Cecilia returns from vacation.

AED Forms

Team discussed how to handle income AEDs and requests. Process developed where the “point person” handles incoming requests for changes and takes the appropriate action: ask requester to fill out an AED form, assign the change or do it themselves. The role of point person will alternate between Karen and Dawn.

In addition, Cecilia will clean up our responses spreadsheet

(1) archive old requests - cannot remove from spreadsheet because it is attached to a form. The “closed” items were hidden. **Complete**

(2) set up a second tab to handle requests which did not come in through the AED form.

NOTE: we cannot add rows to the AED requests spreadsheet - it confuses Google Forms. **Complete.**

(3) Find tutorial that gives detail on sorting and filtering Google Sheets.

TEAMUP ACCESS

Non-committee members have a history of being able to change their TeamUp entries. Committee chairs have also been given update access. We discussed entering DK GREEN entries being loaded into MASTER. Want to revisit.

COMMITTEE MEETING

Moved the time back to Wednesdays 5:00pm in RED committee room.

CREATIVE REPRIEVE

Dawn has been working with leaders. She will arrange a meeting including the CR Board, Cecilia and herself to discuss how best to help these meetings. Cecilia also got a download of Zoom Activity from the LILAC zoom account.

TEAMUP ENTRY INFORMATION

Some meetings have two direct links. We determined that one requires a password and one does not. This can be a cleanup effort to remove the former.

MAY 2024

Update on the Implementation of New Zoom Platforms has four sub projects (no change)

- Change webpage TeamUp presentation -(Design forwarded to Digital Committee but progress will be delayed due to web hosting issues. Meanwhile, Lisa is working on mockups of filtered TeamUp views since they are referenced by new web pages).
 - We will make new slot numbers intelligent; that is, the number will indicate the zoom platform, day and time of the meeting.
- Rename zoom platforms, remove 6-Committee We have discussed this several times, mapping out different systems.
- Add new platforms to Zoom technically **DONE**
- Add new platforms to TeamUp **DONE**

Lisa T. is working on mock-ups of this. Progress impaired by WSBC and website host changes.

Intergroup Representative Basics Workshop

No progress due to WSBC and illness. Next step is to schedule a dry run with group members.

Email Responses

People send emails addressed to info@oafootsteps.com which relate to Meeting Schedule work. There are people on this email distribution list who are not members of our committee and/or do not play an active role with the committee. They respond to these emails however, causing confusion and bypassing our procedures. There is a solution in the works already - when committee reorganization takes place, all of the info@OAFS will go to the Secretary, who will forward the emails to the appropriate email group to meetings@OAFS)..

We should look at the members of meetings@OAFS to ensure it includes committee members only.

Non-Real Time Meetings

Dawn did an audit of meetings on our TeamUp entry and entries on the Non-Real Time meetings webpage, resulting in updating meetings to make them appropriately. We discussed the need for the website page and decided that it contained extraneous information and contained information about NRT events which are not recovery meetings.

- Rename zoom platforms, remove 6-Committee We can move forward with this after World Service Conference.
- Add new platforms to Zoom technically
- Add new platforms to TeamUp

Group Inventory Here are the steps of this process:

- Update inventory file based on Personal Experience. (done)
- Update inventory file based on Zoom Usage (in process but progress delayed due to other projects.)
- Update inventory status based on changes made to meeting in last six months.(done but we need to remove changes which we made based on file download comparison)
- Follow up with contacts and leaders for remaining unverified groups

Daylight Savings Time

We are preparing for the 1teamUp calendar move to DST. Because all meeting are scheduled in Eastern Time, all meeting times will spring forward on Sunday March 10. We will begin posting memes in bulletin boards and a notice above the TeamUp calendar on our website.

Making best use of AO Foot Steps Resources

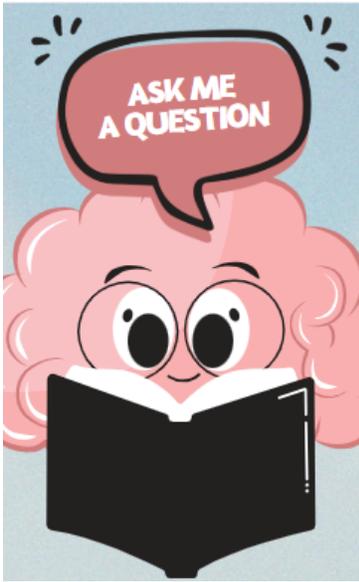
