## **Assessment Results Sent Home**

On Friday, October 15, the spring M-STEP scores from last school year were sent home with each student who took the assessment. Additionally, the fall benchmark assessment scores were also sent home with each student. This assessment covers end of the year grade level skills and can be thought of as a pre-test. We expect scores to be on the lower end because students haven't had the opportunity to learn all of these skills yet. The same assessment will be given again in the spring and those scores will be sent home as well.
