

## Focus: KG ELA & Math Rubric Based Gradebook Setup and Grade Posting Directions

**Purpose:** The purpose of this document is to demonstrate how to set up the regular report card gradebook for KG ELA and Math so you are only having to post a single grade in the gradebook per 9 Weeks. This is instead of entering weekly grades for ELA and Math. <u>KG Teachers still</u> enter the S, N, or U for each standard on the standards report card during the 9 weeks. (<u>Directions for posting standards grades.</u>)

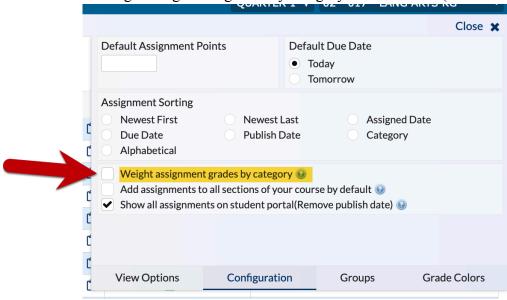

### **Gradebook Settings**

1. When you are in your gradebook, click on the settings icon and verify your setup.



2. Check the "Weight Assignment grades by category" area to see if it is selected or not. Since you only have a single grade for ELA and Math as it comes from the Standards Based Grading Rubric, we are not going to weight the categories. So in this example, make sure the "weight assignment grades by category" is deselected (not selected).



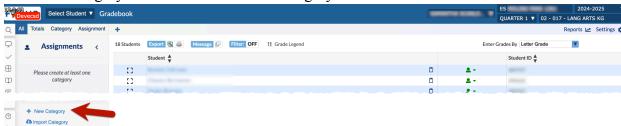

3. Next, it is important to set up a Category. Focus requires at least one (1) category to be set up in your gradebook. If you have not set up at least one category, please set one up. Below is an example:

a. Go to the Category tab and click on "New Category"



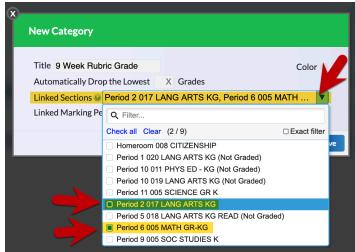
b. When the screen loads, give it a name.



For this example, I am creating a category called "9 Week Rubric Grade."



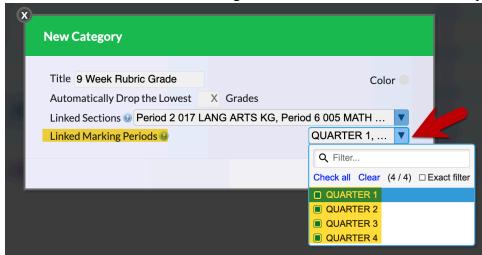
c. Next, I am wanting to link this category to both the ELA and the Math sections. (Note: This is up to you. I went ahead and linked so I only had to set up this category one time.)



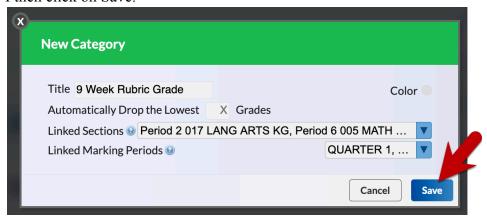

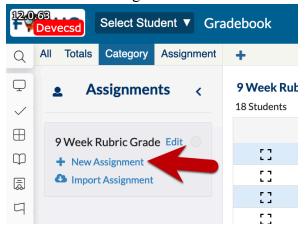
d. I then made sure the Linked Marking Periods were selected for all of the quarters.



e. I then click on Save.



4. The next step is to create the assignment. Click on the Assignment tab. Click on "New Assignment" and a window will pop up.

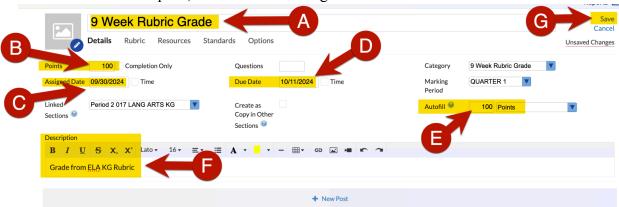

When the new window opens, fill out the following values:



- a. **Title**: Enter a title for the assignment. I suggest using "9 Week Rubric Grade" for the assignment name.
- b. **Points**: Enter in a value for points. I would enter in 100 for the point value.
- c. **Assigned Date**: Check the date in this box. You can use the current date. This date has to be equal to or prior to the last day of the marking period.
- d. **Due Date**: Make the due date the last day of the marking period.
- e. **Autofill**: This is optional. If you are wanting everyone to have an "S" by default, then go ahead and put in 100 points for this value. This is to make sure in step b above, your assignment points possible is 100.
- f. **Description**: Enter a description. For this, I used "Grade from ELA KG Rubric." If this was a Math class, I would have used "Grade from Math KG Rubric."
- g. Save: When everything is done, make sure you click on the "Save" button.
- 5. It is now time to enter grades into the gradebook.
  - a. Before entering, you will need to make sure you change the "Enter Grade By" from "Points" to "Letter Grade."



b. Click on the drop down and make sure you have selected "Letter Grade"

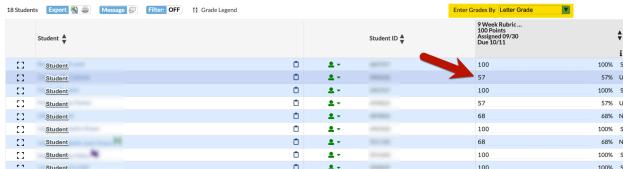

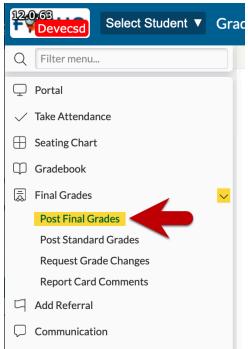
c. You are now ready to enter grades. If you used the auto-fill option, you will just need to change the S value to an N, U, or I for any students that earned that value.



- d. Click in the cell to enter the "Letter Grade" and it should update the grade.
- e. Repeat this for each student based on the K Standards Based Rubric score for the marking period you are in.

### **Posting Final Grades**

1. When it is time to post Quarter or Full Year grades, go to the menu on the left and click on Final Grades and select "Post Final Grades" to bring up the posting screen.

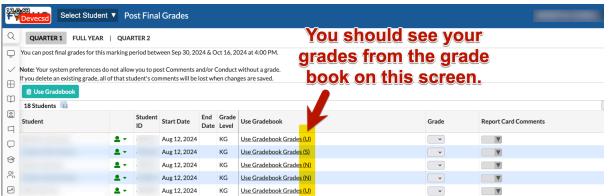

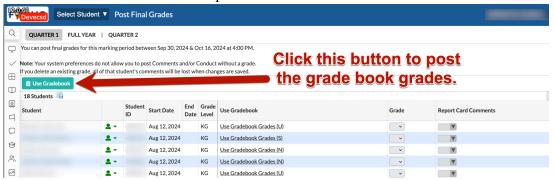
2. When the posting screen loads, make sure you are in the correct marking period for which grades need to be posted. You will also notice you can only post letter grades on this screen.



3. You should also see the grades from your gradebook if you look at the "Use Gradebook" column.



4. Since you have all of your grades in the gradebook, you are now ready to click on the "Use Gradebook" button at the top left of the screen.

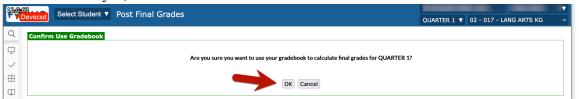

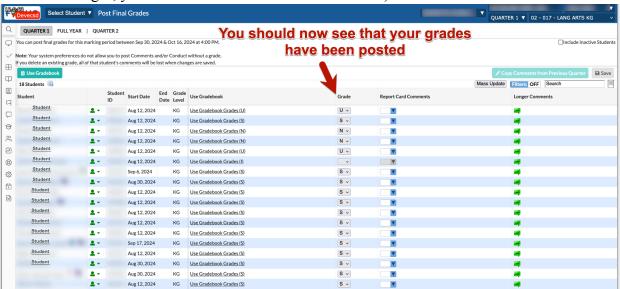

5. Another screen will load asking you to confirm if you want to use your gradebook grades. If the answer is yes, click "OK".



6. The screen will refresh and the system will load the grades you just posted. Review the grades. (The grades should match the grades in the gradebook. If you are making changes on this screen, you will need to make sure your gradebook has been updated as well so you do not appear on the posted grades not matching gradebook report. If you did make changes, you will have to click on the save button.)
