Kindergarten Supply List 2025-2026

- ☐ **1 10 Count Crayola Classic Colors Thick Markers**
- ☐ **1 10 Count Crayola Classic Fine Line Markers**
- ☐ **1 Folder (for schoolwork and communication)**
- ☐ **2 large baby wipe packages (to share with class)**
- ☐ **1 Spiral Notebook ~60-70 pages**

- ☐ **1 Large 16" backpack (or larger)**
This backpack must be large enough to hold up to a 10"x13" folder, their lunch items, a water bottle and a jacket.
- ☐ **2-4"x6" recent photos of the student**
One photo will be posted on the wall in our classroom the entire year, and the other photo will be placed in a class book!
- ☐ **1-4"x6" photo of your family**
This photo will be used for the "My Family" class book.
- ☐ **1 reusable water bottle labeled with your child's name**
- ☐ **1 Simple Headphone, "over the ear" type** labeled with your child's name in a large cloth or Ziploc bag. (wired 3.5mm standard jack, soft, kid friendly)
- ☐ **1-Comfort Kit (see details below)**

Please bring the supplies in a large bag labeled with your child's name to the Meet and Greet 8/29, Work Party 9/3, Classroom Scavenger Hunt/Popsicle Social 9/3, or during the Family Connection Meetings 9/4-9/6. It is also helpful to label your student's folders, headphone, notebook, backpack, water bottle, and comfort kit.
All other school supplies have already been purchased using classroom funds.

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Comfort Kit

We want to make sure our students are adequately prepared and provided for if an emergency occurs while they are at school. Part of the safety plan involves parents providing a comfort kit for each Maplewood student.

Essential items to be included in the comfort kit:

1. Warm hat and gloves
2. Pair of socks
3. One large plastic garbage bag (*e.g., the lawn and garden size to be used as a poncho*)
4. Non-perishable food that your child will eat which does not require water or heat to prepare (*e.g., granola bar, fruit roll-ups, cheese and cracker packs, low-salt tuna or chicken in a pouch. Try to avoid salty or dry foods.*) ***No water or liquids.**

The school will provide water and basic first aid supplies.

Please place all items into a one-gallon freezer zip lock bag and mark the bag with your child's name. The comfort kit can then be turned in to your child's classroom at the start of school and will be stored in the emergency shed near the playground. Comfort kits will be returned to students at the end of the school year.

Note: All items must fit into the Ziploc bag with the top closed. Food needs to be non-perishable and simple to open. Do not include liquids.

Optional items to be included in the comfort kit:

1. Family picture
2. Comfort letter. (*See sample below*) **Sample Letter:** *Have letter with family photo facing out of the bag.*
