January Staff Meeting Notes

Saturday January 21st 7pm EDT

Creative

- Staff reminded of the last speedbuild event of the current revision.
- o Staff informed that the creative changeover schedule will be posted imminently.
- o Request for assistance from staff in adding minor details to the final map.
- Notification that the Gingerbread House contest has been dropped due to lack of participation.
- Staff reminded that the speedbuild arena contest is ongoing, and that the deadline may be extended.
- Notification that Creative is looking into switching versions of WorldEdit, due to various enhancements on offer.
- Notification that the new rev will be running 1.11.2, and the announcement post will be amended accordingly.

PvE

- Staff notified that PAdmins recently had a meeting to determine plans for the remainder of Rev 19, and Rev 20 going forward.
- Staff informed that PAdmins are aiming to announce a tentative start date, for the next rev, a little earlier than has generally been typical in the past.
- PAdmins indicated that they were keen to garner as much feedback as possible, and that mid-rev subreddit/forum posts would be released as of this meeting.
- PAdmins are discussing how best to approach events etc. during the earlier part of the rev, recognising ongoing feedback that suggested big events were disruptive to early gameplay.
- Staff notified that a Valentine's event had been announced.
- Staff reminded of the upcoming Admin Hunt weekend event.
- PAdmins and techs have been discussing an imminent switch to 1.11.2, assuming plugin updating and testing goes well.
- Staff informed that PAdmins would be checking in, individually, with all P-orientated moderators, to make sure everyone was comfortable with all aspects of P moderation.
- Reminder to all staff, to re-read general P related rules on region creation and expansion.
 PAdmins indicated that the PvE moderation guide would be reviewed, in order to ensure rules are as clear as possible.
