Welcome Back to the 2025-2026 School Year!

Dear Eagle Families,

I hope all of our families had a safe, restful, and enjoyable summer break. It's hard to believe how quickly the time has flown, and now we're just about ready to kick off another exciting school year! I'm thrilled to welcome back our students and families as we begin the 2025–2026 school year together.

With each new year comes fresh opportunities and some exciting changes. This year, you'll notice updates to our bell schedule. In our continued effort to support every student, we've introduced a 30-minute Advisory period, Monday through Thursday. During this time, students will engage in AVID strategies, explore career pathways, learn effective study and organizational skills, and monitor their academic progress.

Additionally, we've moved to a unified bell schedule for both junior high and high school students. This change reduces scheduling barriers and opens up more course options for all students. To align with Arizona Department of Education seat-time requirements, the school day will now run from 7:20 AM to 2:42 PM, Monday through Thursday.

Fridays will follow an alternating A/B schedule:

• A Fridays: Periods 1, 3, 5, and 7

B Fridays: Periods 2, 4, Advisory, and 6

EVIT students are required to attend Monday through Friday from 7:20 to 11:26 AM. To support this, we've built a dedicated class period into their Friday schedules.

Our Academic Counselor can answer questions about your student's schedule, which will be on Infinite Campus.

#3 - Public Library Table (3:00-5:00 p.m.)

Register for a public library card. It is free of charge and will assist students in their research.

#4 - Chromebook Assignments

Chromebooks will be assigned on this date to students and parents who have signed the chromebook agreement.

#5 - Senior Station

Seniors will receive important information regarding upcoming Senior activities and deadlines, and pay your Senior Fee.

#6 - Car Lane Assignment

Receive your car lane assignment for student pickup.

#7 - Lunch Program

Payment for enrollment in our lunch program is done quarterly and can only be paid via the IC Parent Portal.

#8 - Electronic Forms and Electronic Payments

Receive assistance completing online forms and payments. All 7th-12th grade students must have their <u>chromebook</u> <u>agreements signed</u>. We encourage you to do this before Eagle Day. ALL Chromebooks will be handed out the first day of school. Fees include the <u>Eagle Pack</u> fee and the <u>Life Fund</u>.

#9 - Sports Information

Our Athletic Director will be available to answer any questions regarding sports programs.

<u>Driving students:</u> Please visit the B3 front desk to apply for a parking permit.

Student drivers must register their vehicle with EDUPRIZE High School. In order to register your vehicle, you must bring a copy of a valid driver's license, registration, and vehicle insurance to apply for a parking spot. The cost is **\$100 per year** through <u>Infinite Campus</u>.

Walking/Biking students: Please visit the B3 front desk to apply for a walking/riding pass

Students must have an approved walking/riding pass to walk or bike to/from school.

B3 Nurse office: Our school nurse will be available to answer any questions and collect medication.

EAGLE DAY STUDENT FEES: All fees are non-refundable and non-transferable.

<u>Educational Enhancement Fund</u>: **\$50** is due and payable at Eagle Day or before the first day of school. This is for all 7th-12th Graders and covers technology fees.

<u>LIFE Fund</u>: **\$50**, if not yet paid, is due and payable at Eagle Day. This offsets Field Trip transportation and entrance costs. Students who do not pay the LIFE Fund will not be eligible to attend Field Trips.

<u>Senior Fee</u>: \$100 is due and payable at Eagle Day. This covers the Diploma, Diploma Cover, Stole and Cords, Senior Breakfast, and Graduation Expenses. This is for graduating Seniors only. \$100 payable on Infinite Campus. Please include the Senior's Name and "Senior Fee" with the payment.

- School starting bell rings at 7:20 am
- All students must be on time and present the entire day to be considered enrolled at EDUPRIZE.
- Before the starting bell: 7th-12th grade students assemble on the courtyard east of Building 3.
- All students will need their schedule to enter the campus.

- Friday Early Release is at 12:00 pm
