The large fellowship hall on the lower level is approximately 1725 square feet of usable space, with ca. 12 8' tables, and approximately 100 chairs. A full kitchen is adjacent. There is a piano.



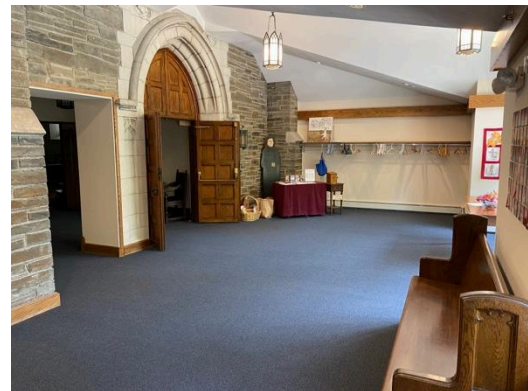
There are several smaller spaces downstairs and upstairs: a library, classrooms, and the like, that could accommodate small meetings, tutoring sessions, private zoom space...you name it....



Just inside the front door is a lounge, seating up to around 8, ideal for sun- (or cloud-) filled meetings. Basic kitchen adjacent.



For a small reception of up to 25, the gathering space just inside the front door could be useful, and a basic kitchen is adjacent. A nursery is nearby as well.



And of course, for certain larger events, we can consider using the sanctuary, equipped with fixed seating for up to 200, a webcasting system with up to three cameras, sound system, pipe organ, upright piano, and a dedicated children's area.
