Location

Sebastopol Bowls Club - 210-219 Albert St, Sebastopol. Playing can be accessed via the Albert St entrance (either directly onto the rinks via the side entrance, or through the bistro).

Rinks

The rinks being used will be under the dome. The rinks and areas surrounding will be tidy upon the commencement of the competition. It would be helpful if all students ensure they pick up all of their rubbish and place it in the bins provided. No food and drink are allowed on the rinks.

Structure of event

- Teams must arrive and register by 10:10am
- Play will commence at 10:30am
- Official rules are to be followed and can be accessed on the [SSV website](#).

Team Size

- Each side will have 6 players (making up 2 x teams of 3). A spare player for each team is permitted and can be rotated throughout the tournament. Schools can enter in as many sides as they like.
- All teams are considered mixed/open and can be made up of any number of boys or girls.

Draw

- The Draw will be published on the [SSV website](#) once available (relevant to the closing date for team entries). Teams are advised to check this the evening prior to competition for any changes.
- Results from the day will be posted on the [SSV website](#) following the day.

Referees

Sebastopol Bowls Club will be supplying most of the umpire but school staff/support adults may be asked to assist with the umpiring/rink management.

First Aid

All schools are required to supply their own trained first aid personnel and bring along all required first aid supplies for their students.

Parking

There is ample car parking available at this venue. Parking for larger vehicles is on Albert St.

Progression to the Region event

The top team on the day will move onto the [Greater Western Region Championships](#) to be held at Sebastopol Bowls Club (213-219 Albert St, Sebastopol) on 2 September, 2025.

Nature of the tournament

Students are attending from the Sovereign and Eureka Division areas to experience sport at a local level. All students are playing to enhance their own opportunities in life and to be a part of a team. In doing so we ask all students to play fairly and have fun.

Code of Conduct:

All SSV events follow the [Sporting Schools Victoria Codes of Conduct](#). Please ensure staff, students, coaches and supporters familiarise themselves with these prior to the event.

Disputes

Any disputes regarding decisions should be first directed to the event convenor. Only team managers are permitted to voice this dispute. This can either be conducted through a written complaint or verbal complaint. Whichever the case the dispute will be discussed by the event convenor and the umpires in charge of that game. A decision will be reached immediately which we ask to be respected by all parties involved.

Unsportsmanlike conduct

In the event of unsportsmanlike conduct the following will occur:

- *Players*- First instance- is given a warning, Second instance- be sent off and will take no further part in the present game, Third instance- be disqualified from partaking in the remainder of the carnival
- *Team Officials*- First instance- is given a warning, Second instance- is asked to leave the venue.
- *Spectators*- First instance- is given a warning, Second instance- is asked to leave the venue.
- *Disqualifying Teams*- In the event that a team has been given repeated warnings and still breach the unsportsmanlike conduct they will be disqualified from the competition and be stripped of all championship points. Also a letter will be drafted and sent to the SSV informing them of the situation.
