Extended Season

- Nicole can open registration whenever we need to. Nicole wants all directors to reach out to their current parents and see who is willing to coach for the extended season.

- April 1st to April 30th, adding an additional month of hockey. All games, no practices.
 Thinking \$100 for four weeks, two ice times.
- Oo we allow the 2nd year players the option to move up. This allows players to experience the older level and get used to it before moving up next season. Discussion about safety and number especially regarding U13s moving to U15 which is currently combined with U18. We will go through registration and see what numbers are like before seeing about moving students up.

Evaluations for Next Season

- There wasn't too much negative feedback about how we did evaluations last year. We
 have a few outside evaluators that are interested in coming up and helping out with
 tryouts. Parents will not know who the evaluators are until day off as parents harassed
 our evaluators.
- Another critique was there were too many kids on the ice time. So we are looking to do
 more ice slots and less kids on the ice to get a more fair evaluation. Other associations
 are also following our lead. We have some things that need to change. Matt will start
 looking at creating a plan for what evaluations will look like and bring it to a future
 meeting.
- Matt is going to reach out to shoot to score and Marc is looking at Ketchen hockey. Could also reach out to the Valentinos about evaluating. Let's have options to choose from regarding evaluations.
- Discussions about having tryouts during the first week of September.

Coach Selection

- We will be opening up for looking for coaches for U18, U15 AA, U15 A, U13 AA, U13 A, U13 B, U11 AA, U11 A, U11 B. Cristy is going to make a poster and will get Matt's approval before posting.
- Deadline of April 21st 2024.
- Coaches will be interviewed and will be notified before the AGM. This way coaches can start looking for tournaments.

• U9 Ice Time

Because of tournaments some ice times have been canceled because of tournaments.
 Some parents are complaining about these ice times. Leslie is going to be trying to reschedule some of these ice times to make it up.

U9 has had 46 ice times and revenue of \$12 050. Ice costs \$6500 for december. The \$12 050 covers ice times, referees, tournament registration and miscellaneous cost.

U9 Tournament

Budget has been made. They are expecting a revenue of \$17000 made up of registration, 50/50, loonie stick, candy count, silent auction, plinko, FUN night. Expected expenses of \$7900 made up of music, ice, referees, awards, decorations, tournament room. Expected profit is \$9100.
