

How to Host a Successful Diaper Drive

Thank you for agreeing to host a diaper drive! Diaper drives like yours are one of the primary ways that Jake's Network of Hope collects diapers, wipes, and money to help low-income families keep their little ones clean and healthy.

We have compiled a list of suggestions based on our experience helping many groups like yours host successful diaper drives.

- 1. **Pick the right place for your collection site.** Where you gather diapers during your diaper drive can make a huge difference in the drive's success. Make sure you collect diapers in a place that is:
 - Out in the open think corner of the room instead of a closet
 - Easy to access make sure everyone can easily get to the spot where you're collecting diapers
- 2. **Check out our Diaper Drive Tool Kit.** This kit includes flyers, collection signs, tax receipts and email templates. It's a great place to start when you need to let people know about your diaper drive.
- 3. **Let people know about the diaper drive early.** Don't wait until the first day of your diaper drive to start telling people when it'll be happening. Feel free to use this schedule:



- Two weeks before your diaper drive Casually mention the upcoming diaper drive to your closest colleagues or friends in the group that will be hosting the drive.
- One week prior to your diaper drive Put up the Diaper Drive Sign (found in the Diaper Drive Toolkit) in common areas where people can see it.
- Wednesday or Thursday the week before your diaper drive Send email 1 from the Diaper Drive Email Templates, post to social media
- Day one of your diaper drive Send email 2, post to social media
- Midway through your diaper drive Send email 3, post to social media
- Final day of your diaper drive Send email 4, post to social media
- 4. **Let everyone know about the diaper drive's success.** After your diaper drive is over, be sure to communicate the outcomes of your drive with those that donated and to your followers. We will give you a final tally of diapers, wipes and financial donations. It's a great idea to let people know these results!
