SCC Booth Ferris South (Divided): Directions for Use

General Directions

- 1. Press the touch screen, on the wall-mounted A/V box in Booth Ferris North. This will activate the system.
- Press the Sources button on the touch screen.
- 3. Choose your source:

HDMI VGA USB-C Bluray

Once a source is selected, the screen and projector will activate.

- 4. To control the volume, press Volume ▲ ▼ on the right side of the touch screen. Above the Volume ▲ is a Program / Speech button. Toggle between Program and Speech by pressing the button. Program controls the audio from a Source selection, Speech controls the audio from the wireless mics. The Mute button mutes all audio.
- Press the Video Mute button to hide the projected image.
 N.B. Do NOT use Video Mute to shut down, you will burn up the projector.
- 6. Press the **Power** button to completely shut down the system when finished.

To view a laptop computer

- 1. Attach the HDMI, VGA or USB-C cable at the A/V box to your laptop.
- Press HDMI, VGA or USB-C source on the touch screen.
- 3. Control your laptop via its own controls.

To view a Blu-ray

- 1. Press **Bluray** source on the touch screen.
- 2. Insert your disc into the Blu-ray player.
- 3. Control the video via the touch screen control panel.

Microphone Use

- 1. Obtain a wireless microphone from the SCC staff.
- 2. Turn it on.
- Press Program on the touch screen. It will change to Speech.
- 4. Control the mic volume with the **Volume** extstyle extstyle
- 5. Press **Speech** again to return to volume control of **Program** (regular use).

Final Shutdown

- 1. Eject all Blu-ray Discs, DVDs, etc.
- 2. Press the **Power** button on the touch screen.
- 3. "Are you sure you want to exit and shut the system down?" Press "Yes".
- 4. The projector will cool down and shut off automatically. The screen will retract.
- 5. Return any mics or cables to the SCC staff.
