## Grading for Semester 2 (*Note change from Semester 1 Grading*):

Your Unit Average for each of Units 4, 5 and 6 will be a weighted average according to the following:

- 20%- Quiz 1 (If you score below an 80% on Quiz 1, you can revise and bring your grade up to an 80%, just like before.)
- 10%- Quiz 2 (This will sometimes be a partner quiz, like before, and you will not have a chance to make revisions on this if you get a low score.)
- 50%- Unit Test
- 15%- Delta Math and other submitted HW
- 5%- Class Participation (Potential scores: 95, 93, 90, 85, 80, 75, 65. One exception, if your average without participation is above a 95 and your class work and participation are strong, see below, I will raise your CP grade to match your average.)

Your Semester 2 grade will be the average of your Unit 4, 5 and 6 grades.

## Skills based problems on Delta Math.

Advice: Try not to leave this Delta Math work until the last minute, learning geometry is very cumulative, if you keep up practicing often, you will have a good base for building a strong understanding of new/future material
