

Privacy Policy – Reddit Digest

Effective date: 31 July 2026 · **Last updated:** 4 August 2026

The short version. Reddit Digest summarizes Reddit posts and comments using AI. To do that it needs an account (your email address) and it has to send the text you want summarized to an AI provider. It does not track your browsing, does not record the pages you visit, does not show ads, and does not sell your data to anyone, ever.

Reddit Digest also offers an optional paid Pro plan. If you upgrade, payment is entered directly into our payment processor's own secure page – we never see or store your card details. See [Section 6 – Payments and subscriptions](#).

The other thing worth reading in full is [Section 5 – the AI provider](#), because the text you summarize is processed outside the browser.

1. Who this covers

This policy describes how the **Reddit Digest** browser extension ("the extension", "we") handles information. It applies to the extension published on the Chrome Web Store and to the backend service the extension talks to. It does not cover Reddit itself, or any other website you visit – those have their own policies.

The extension runs only on `reddit.com` and its subdomains. On every other website it is inert: no code of ours runs, and nothing is read or collected.

2. What we collect, and how

2.1 Information you give us directly

Data	When	Why
Email address	When you create an account or sign in.	It identifies your account so your skills, usage, and plan follow you between devices.

Password	When you create an account or sign in.	To authenticate you. It is sent over HTTPS to our authentication provider, which stores it only as a salted cryptographic hash. We never see, store, or have any way to recover your plaintext password.
"Skills" you write	When you create or edit a skill in the extension's settings.	A skill is an instruction you write (for example, "give me three bullet points"). It is stored on your account and sent to the AI provider along with the text being summarized.

2.2 Information collected automatically when you use the feature

Data	When	Why
The text you asked to summarize	Only at the moment you click to summarize. This is either the text you highlighted, or the post and top comments the extension reads from the Reddit page you are on.	It is the input to the summary. It is capped at 6,000 characters per request.
A monthly usage count	Each time a summary is generated.	A number, per account, used to enforce a fair-use limit of 30 free summaries per month. It records <i>how many</i> summaries you ran, never <i>what</i> they were about. Pro removes this limit for normal use; we may review unusually high usage to prevent abuse of the service.
Subscription and billing status	When you upgrade, renew, or cancel the Pro plan.	Whether your account is Free or Pro, when a subscription renews, and whether it is set to cancel. This comes to us from our payment processor, Polar — see Section 6 — not typed directly into the extension.

Technical request data	Every network request.	Our service providers receive your IP address and browser user-agent as an unavoidable part of serving any internet request. We do not use these to build a profile of you, and we do not run any analytics, telemetry, or advertising software in the extension.

2.3 Stored only on your own device

The following never leave your computer. They live in the browser's extension storage and are erased when you uninstall the extension:

- Your login session token, so you are not asked to sign in repeatedly.
- A cached copy of your own skills, so the panel opens instantly.
- Your preference for how many top comments to include (1–20).

3. What we do *not* collect

This list is deliberate. The extension is built so that these are not technically possible, not merely discouraged:

- **Your browsing history or the URLs you visit.** The address of the page you are on is never sent to us. The summarize request contains only the text and your chosen instruction – nothing that identifies the page, thread, or subreddit beyond what appears in the text itself.
- **Your Reddit account.** The extension does not ask for, read, or use your Reddit username, password, cookies, or login session. It has no Reddit permissions of any kind.
- **Any activity outside reddit.com.** The extension is not permitted to run anywhere else.
- **Keystrokes, mouse movement, scrolling, clicks, or form contents.**
- **Your card number, CVV, or billing address.** If you upgrade to Pro, payment is entered directly into our payment processor's own checkout page – the extension and our servers never see, receive, or store it. See [Section 6](#).
- **Health, government identification, or biometric data.** The extension has no feature that would ask for any of it.
- **Location data.**

4. How your information is used

Your data is used for one purpose: to operate the summarizing feature you asked for. Specifically:

- To sign you in and keep you signed in.
- To store and sync the skills you wrote.
- To generate the summary you requested.
- To count your summaries against the free monthly limit, and to recognize when a Pro subscription removes it.
- To process a Pro upgrade or cancellation you initiate, and to keep your plan status accurate.
- To detect and prevent abuse, fraud, and technical failures.
- To comply with the law where we are legally required to.

Your data is **never** used for advertising or ad targeting, sold or transferred to data brokers or advertising networks, used to assess creditworthiness or for lending decisions, or used for any purpose unrelated to the summarizing feature.

5. The AI provider — please read this

The text you choose to summarize is sent to DeepSeek, an AI company based in China, and is processed on servers in the People's Republic of China.

According to DeepSeek's own privacy policy, data it receives may be retained and may be used to train and improve its models. We do not control this, and we cannot delete data on your behalf once it has been sent.

What this means in practice: do not use this extension to summarize anything you would not be comfortable sending to a third-party AI company — including private messages, confidential information, or anything you consider sensitive. Summarizing an ordinary public Reddit thread sends text that is already public; summarizing something private does not.

Nothing is sent to DeepSeek unless you actively click to summarize. Opening a Reddit page, highlighting text, or opening the panel sends nothing.

6. Payments and subscriptions

Reddit Digest's Pro plan is optional. The free plan works fully without ever giving us any payment information — nothing in this section applies unless you choose to upgrade.

Payment is handled entirely by **Polar**, our payment processor, on Polar's own hosted checkout page. When you click **Upgrade**, the extension opens that page in a new tab; it is not part of the extension and is not something we can see into.

- **What Polar receives.** Your email address (so Polar can send you a receipt), and whatever payment details you enter directly into Polar's page — card number, billing address, and so on. Those never pass through the extension or our servers at any point; you are typing them straight into Polar's page, not ours. Polar's own privacy policy governs that data: polar.sh/legal/privacy-policy.
- **What Polar sends back to us.** Only subscription metadata — a Polar customer ID, a subscription ID, its status (active, canceled, and so on), and the date it renews or ends. Never your card number, never a full billing address.
- **Cancelling.** The **Manage subscription** button opens a Polar-hosted portal where you can cancel yourself, with no email required. Cancelling stops the next renewal; Pro access continues until the period you already paid for ends, at which point your account returns to Free automatically.
- **Linking a payment to your account.** When you check out, we tell Polar your account ID so a completed payment can be matched back to your account and upgrade it. That internal ID is not your email address and identifies nothing outside Reddit Digest.

7. Who else your data reaches

We do not sell your data, and we do not share it for anyone else's marketing. Data reaches only these three service providers, each strictly to run a feature you used:

Provider	What it receives	Why
Supabase (hosting, database, authentication)	Your email address, hashed password, the skills you wrote, your usage count, your subscription status, and — in transit only, never written to the database — the text being summarized.	It hosts the account system and the servers that talk to the AI provider and to Polar.

DeepSeek (the AI model)	Only the text you asked to summarize and the skill instruction you chose. It never receives your email address, your account identity, or the page address.	It generates the summary. See Section 5 .
Polar (payment processing)	Your email address and whatever you enter on Polar's checkout page, if and only if you upgrade to Pro. See Section 6 .	It processes the payment and manages the subscription.

We may also disclose information if we are legally compelled to, or where necessary to investigate abuse or protect the safety of users. If ownership of the extension ever changes hands, we will give notice before any personal data is transferred, and this policy will continue to apply until you are told otherwise.

8. How your data is stored and protected

- **Everything is encrypted in transit.** Every connection the extension makes uses HTTPS (TLS). No data is ever sent over plain HTTP.
- **Data is isolated per account.** The database enforces row-level security, so one account cannot read, edit, or delete another account's skills or usage — this is enforced by the database itself, not merely by application code.
- **Your usage record is read-only to you.** Nobody, including you, can rewrite their own quota.
- **The AI provider's key never touches your browser.** It exists only as a server-side secret. The extension has no ability to call the AI provider directly.
- **Our own systems cannot read payment details.** Checkout happens entirely on Polar's page; our servers only ever receive subscription status back, never card data.
- **The part of the extension that runs on Reddit pages holds no credentials.** Your login token is kept in the extension's privileged background context, never injected into any web page, so a compromised or malicious web page cannot read it.
- **No remote code.** The extension executes only the code included in its package. It does not download or run code from anywhere at runtime.

No system is perfectly secure, and we cannot guarantee absolute security. If we ever become aware of a breach affecting your personal data, we will notify affected users without undue delay.

9. How long we keep it

Data	Kept for	Deleted when
Email address and account record	As long as your account exists.	You delete your account.
Skills you wrote	Until you delete them.	You delete the skill, or delete your account.
Monthly usage counts	As long as your account exists.	You delete your account.
Subscription status and Polar identifiers	As long as your account exists.	You delete your account, and we stop syncing further updates. Polar independently retains payment and transaction records for as long as financial recordkeeping law requires, governed by Polar's own policy — deleting your Reddit Digest account does not delete Polar's records of a payment that already happened.
The text you summarized	Not stored by us at all. It is held in memory only for the seconds the request takes, and is never written to our database or logs.	Immediately, when the request finishes. Retention at the AI provider is governed by their policy , not ours.
Session token, cached skills, preferences	On your device only.	You sign out or uninstall the extension.

10. Your rights and how to use them

- **See your data.** Everything we hold about you is visible in the extension's settings page: your email address, your skills, and your usage count.

- **Change it.** Edit or delete any skill at any time in the settings page. Changes take effect immediately.
- **Cancel Pro.** Use the **Manage subscription** button in the extension at any time — no email needed. See [Section 6](#).
- **Delete everything.** Email us at the address below from the address on your account and ask for deletion. We will delete your account and everything attached to it — skills, usage records, and the account itself — within 30 days, and confirm when it is done. Deleting the extension from Chrome erases everything stored on your device immediately, but does not by itself delete your server-side account.
- **Withdraw consent.** Sign out, or uninstall the extension. Once signed out, the extension cannot send anything anywhere.
- Depending on where you live, you may also have the right to a copy of your data in a portable format, to object to or restrict processing, and to complain to your local data protection authority. Write to us and we will help.

11. Limited Use commitment

Our use of information received from the extension adheres to the [Chrome Web Store User Data Policy](#), including the Limited Use requirements. Specifically, we affirm that data collected by this extension is:

- used only to provide or improve the single, user-facing purpose the extension is listed for;
- never sold, and never transferred to advertising platforms, data brokers, or information resellers;
- never used or transferred to determine creditworthiness or for lending purposes;
- never used for personalized advertising of any kind;
- never read by humans, unless we have your explicit consent for a specific issue, it is necessary for security or to comply with the law, or the data has been aggregated and anonymized.

12. Children

Reddit Digest is not directed at children and is not intended for anyone under 13 (or the minimum age of digital consent where you live, if higher). We do not knowingly collect data from children. If you believe a child has created an account, contact us and we will delete it.

13. Changes to this policy

If this policy changes in a way that materially affects how your data is handled, we will update the "last updated" date at the top and, where the change is significant, give notice in the extension itself before it takes effect. Continued use after a change means you accept the updated policy.
