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Welcome to the Little Chargers Preschool Program!

SCHEDULE: The 3-day session will be a Monday/Wednesday/Thursday (full days) and the 2-day session will be Tuesday/Friday (full days). Students that are 4 or 5 years of age as of September 1st would come on M/W/TH and students that are 3 years old as of September 1st will attend on T/F. The first day of school is Tuesday, September 3 for the T/F group and Wednesday, September 4 for the M/W/TH group.

TUITION: Tuition for the Little Chargers 3-day session is \$900 per year and \$600 per year for the 2-day session. A \$50 fee is required prior to the start of the school year, along with a completed payment plan form. Please take a moment to fill out the educational benefits application and see if you qualify for the free/reduced meals. There will be no tuition charge for qualifying families.

TRANSPORTATION: All Little Chargers will be able to be picked up on regular bus routes in the mornings. Westbrook students would then ride the appropriate shuttle bus to and from Walnut Grove. Students will then return home on the regular routes in the afternoon.

Any changes to a student's regular after-school schedule would need to be handled with a phone call from the parent to the school office by 2:00 PM (1:00 on Wednesdays). Office personnel would then let the Preschool staff know about the change and issue a bus pass if necessary.

BREAKFAST/DINNER: This year Preschool – 6th grade students receive free breakfast and lunch regardless of family income. Westbrook and Walnut Grove Preschool students would eat breakfast together once the WB shuttle arrives in Walnut Grove. All parents will still be required to fill out a free/reduced lunch application. This information contributes to helping our school with funding. Preschool students will also participate in a daily fresh fruit and vegetable snack program provided by the school.

LIBRARY: The Little Chargers visit the school library weekly and are allowed to check out books. Please remember to send those books back to school with them on Tuesday/Wednesday of the next week, depending on their class session day.

NAPS: Little Chargers will have a daily naptime. Each student is required to bring his/her own sleeping mat or rug.

EXPECTATIONS FOR ATTENDEES: All students participating in the Little Chargers Preschool need to be day-time potty trained.

SUPPLIES: WWG School will provide a list of the supplies needed for preschool. Students should provide their own backpacks to take their projects home in. The Walnut Grove office has extra backpacks if you need one. Students should also have an extra set of clothes to be kept in their locker in the case of an accident.
