Getting to the Event

- The event will be held in the Spectrum Center, which is located in the Michigan
 Union building. The Michigan Union is located at 530 S. State Street. The building
 is located across the street from the University of Michigan Art Museum.
- Bus routes 62, 6, and 24 have stops along the S. State that stop close to the Michigan Union. For more information about bus routes visit theride.org

 If you are driving, there is a visitor parking lot at 400 Thompson St, near the Student Activities Building. Street metered parking is available along S. State, E.
 Williams Ave, and some other roads around the Trotter Multicultural Center.

Building and Space Description

- Description of space
 - o The event will be held at The Michigan Union in the Spectrum Center. The Spectrum Center is located on the third floor in suite 3020. You can access the third floor of the union by stairs and by elevator.

Physical Accessibility

- o The Michigan Union is accessible by both stairs and a ramp. The front doors of the Union are only accessible by stairs, but there is an entrance on the north side of the building that is wheelchair accessible. Once inside the building the third floor can be accessed by both my stairs and an elevator. When entering the North side of the building there is a set of elevators to the right, which all floors are accessible from. Below a floor plan of the Michigan Union is available.
 - The doors on the building are not automatic, but the north entrance has a button to open the door.
 - The Michigan Union has hard floors, but the Spectrum Center itself is carpeted.


Restrooms

- o There is a mens, womens and all gender restroom on every floor of the building and every all gender restroom within the building is wheelchair accessible.
 - The ground floor of the building has a Mens, womens, and all gender restroom located to the left of the Michigan Union Ticket Office.

- The first floor has a mens, womens, and all gender restroom located in front of Panera Bread.
- The second floor has a mens and womens restroom located to the right of the IdeaHub. Two all gender restrooms are available across from the IdeaHub and to the right of the elevators.
- The third floor has mens and womens restrooms across the hall from MESA. An all gender restroom is located to the right of the elevators.
