Joyful Leadership is not your ordinary training course – it's much more! In order to get the most from this experience, you should read the manual first to gain general knowledge of Joyful Leadership, then proceed to the online course where you'll learn more about specific leadership concepts, and then complete the application for this live training course.

Aims of the training course

- To increase the participants capacity and professional skills in the field of leadership so they can become better leaders in their organisations To develop the leadership potential of youth workers, equipping them with the skills necessary to nurture and inspire future leaders committed to organizational and societal change.
- To promote the concept of Joyful Leadership, the training cycle (manual, online course, training course), and its benefits for youth workers



You will have the chance to get to know the Joyful Leadership trainers in person, meet other motivated young leaders and exchange experiences with them, and participate in interactive, engaging and challenging activities.

Whom are we looking for?

- youth workers committed to motivating and guiding young people to tackle leadership challenges
- youth workers in leading positions (or aspiring to take leading positions) in their organisations
- youth workers committed to participating in the whole training cycle (manual, online course, training course, follow-up activities)
- youth workers committed to their job
- youth workers wanting to learn new tools and non-formal education methods
- participants with good communication skills in English (B2 level)

Selection criteria

Compulsory (you will not be selected unless you fulfill all of the below):

- ☐ Good knowledge of spoken and written English (B2)
- ☐ Read the manual
- ☐ Complete the Joyful Leadership online course
- ☐ Fill in PART 1 OF THE APPLICATION FORM: contact info, motivation statement, English level self-assessment (link will be available at the end of the online course)

Optional (give you additional selection points)

- ☐ Fill in PART 2 OF THE APPLICATION FORM: knowledge quiz (based on the manual and online course) - to be found at the end of the application form
- ☐ Recommendation from your sending organisation: this will be communicated directly with your sending organisation

Traveling

The project will take place from **8th December to 16th December 2024 (including travel days)** at [The Radhé Resort](#) in Somogyvámos, Hungary. You are expected to arrive in Somogyvámos on 8th December by the evening and leave on 16th in the morning. Travel is allowed up to two days before or after the dates of the project but in this case, you have to cover your accommodation yourself.

The project is funded by the Erasmus+ programme and is **free of charge**. The hosting organisation will provide accommodation, food, working materials, and you will also receive **travel cost reimbursement**. Please, see below the maximum amounts we can reimburse for participants traveling from a certain country:

Croatia, Hungary,	211 EUR per participant (285 EUR for green travel)
Belgium, France, Latvia, Poland	309 EUR per participant (417 EUR for green travel)
Spain	395 EUR per participant (535 EUR for green travel)

 We encourage all participants to take on eco-friendly travel options, such as train, bus and carpooling, when possible. For participants coming from distances less than 500 km to the training venue it is compulsory to travel by eco-friendly means.

In order to receive the travel cost reimbursement, you will have to:

- ☐ Provide ALL ORIGINAL tickets, boarding passes etc. (for example, **if you lose a boarding pass, we won't be able to reimburse you**)
- ☐ Fill in the Participant Report at the end of the project
- ☐ Conduct an onsite dissemination activity (e.g. workshop, presentation, or related event within your organisation, network, or community) and document it. Complement this with an online post about the activity. We will provide detailed guidelines and support materials to selected participants.

Please keep in mind that your application will be considered **only after** you fill in the first part of the application form.

APPLICATION DEADLINE: 03 November 2024

* To give you more time to complete the online course and finish reading the manual, you don't have to have everything done before the application deadline. You can still complete up to 20% of the online course after you're selected. However, the more you do before the deadline, the easier it will be for you to answer the questions in the quiz 😊

We will let you know about the selection results by the end of July. Do not book any tickets before you receive the confirmation of participation.
