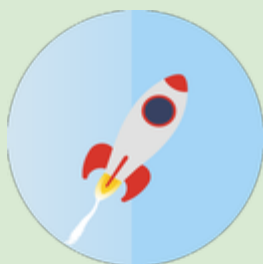

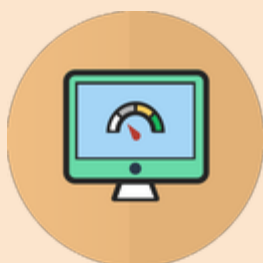
## Why use it?

- Adaptive in real-time; allows students to move through content quickly if they know it and has multiple layers of support for students who don't
- Lots of "offline" teacher resources (intervention lessons / practice worksheets) that make your life easier
- Students have choice in what activity they can work on and their progress is very visible to them



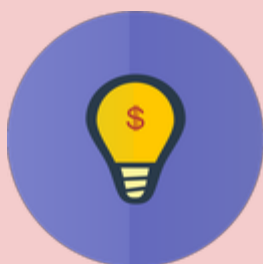
## Best Practices / Quick Wins:

- Have students focus on "turning the gray boxes green"
- Make sure students understand and know how to use the repeat instructions & repeat prompt buttons. Pay attention to the dashboard and use the recommended interventions to support students who get stuck
- Use the "Skills" report as a way to create targeted student groups



## Data Tracking / Student Celebration:

- Teachers can download the app (myLexia) to check data on your phone
- Students get certificates for each level they pass - print them out and celebrate!
- Make a big deal about the various "places around the world" so that students are excited to see where they go next



## Common Pitfalls

- Difficult to see what activities within a level each student is working on / has mastered in one place
- Some of the images used to stand for vocabulary are not as clear as they could be
- Show students progress bar at bottom of each unit. They lose what they have done if they don't finish the level before logging out.
