Marius - The great Man of the Army

Gaius Marius was the man who organized the army into the most effective fighting machine on Earth. At times, it appeared nothing could withstand the mighty legions of Rome. It was Marius who changed the way the army organised itself. Men from the provinces could now sign up to serve in the Roman army, and in time become Roman citizens themselves. So too was it Marius who granted land to the veterans of the legions in reward for their services.

He also won some famous battles with his new army, most famous of all the Aquae Sextiae and Campi Raudii, where his victories saved Italy and Rome from an invasion of barbarians from the north.
