  - Software Developer with a passion for delivering on your project's vision.

## CONTACT INFORMATION

- ☐ Did you update your **URL** and personalize it? ([www.linkedin.com/in/yourname](http://www.linkedin.com/in/yourname)).
- ☐ Did you fill out your best **contact information** so people can reach you?
- ☐ Have you added the **"open to work"** banner to indicate that you're open to new opportunities? This helps recruiters and hiring managers know you are looking for a role.

## ABOUT

- ☐ Does your **summary** demonstrate your passion for working in the target industry? Is it easy to skim? Adding spaces between paragraphs makes it easier to read.
- ☐ Have you added a **call to action** at the end of your about, inviting your readers to connect and **why**?

## ROLE HISTORY

- ☐ Did you fill out the **experience section**, letting recruiters know at a glance your achievements and adding a metric if possible? **Read more about this [here](#).**

## EDUCATION

- ☐ Did you fill out the **education section**? Including your Turing certificate.

## ENDORSEMENTS

- ☐ **Do you have relevant industry-specific skills** with the most important as the top 3?

## RECOMMENDATIONS

- ☐ Have you received at least one **recommendation**? Return the favor and write one for them.

**Featured section:** Pin a project, blog post, or other media of what you want to share with your network.

**Certifications and courses:** Listing relevant credentials doesn't hurt.

**Honors, Awards, publications:** Share what's important to you and why. Using visuals of linked documents, videos, or articles.

**Interests:** A great way to expand your network is to join Groups: Join college alumni groups, professional associations, industry industry-related groups and engage with like-minded professionals.

**Projects and accomplishments:** highlight Turing and other professional Projects

**Volunteer work:** Provide details about your involvement in causes you care about and support.
