All students in Grades 10, 11 and 12 will require the basic items: pencil case, pencils, ballpoint pens, eraser, ribbon-style white-out, ruler, math set, pencil crayons, markers, scissors, glue stick and loose-leaf paper. All students will need a set of headphones (especially if taking distance learning). All students will need a backpack to carry supplies to and from class, and a personal water bottle. All students in Grades 10 through 12 need a scientific calculator for their math and science courses. Students will not be permitted to use the calculator on a cell phone. Students who intend to take all the math courses possible should obtain a graphing calculator, preferably a Texas Instruments model TI-83 Plus or TI-84.

NEW: Starting the 2025-2026 school year students will be required to bring their own combination lock or they may purchase one from SHS for \$10 on the first day of school. It is an expectation that all students lock their lockers and keep them locked.

Grade 10 Industrial Arts	vinyl eraser, duotang and safety glasses. Students will construct several teacher-determined projects during the semester. Students may have an opportunity to choose a project to make at their own expense.
Food Studies 10 & 30	1 - 2" 3-ring binder, a box of large zipper closure bags (15) and an apron
Wellness 10, Physical Education 20 & 30	Students will need a separate pair of indoor-only runners, an appropriate change of clothes to be active, eye protection (goggles or shatterproof glasses), a ball glove and a badminton racquet. The goggles and badminton racquets can be ordered anytime through the school. Students will also need access to a CSA-approved hockey helmet and skates for skating. Adapted ice hockey additionally requires access to a CSA-approved helmet with cage, elbow pads, gloves, and a throat protector. A school-appropriate swimsuit will be needed in June (clean tank tops or drawstring shorts can be worn over swimsuits, if needed/desired). Wellness 10 Only - a \$20-\$40 student fee (TBD) will be collected towards the Treeosix field trip in June.
Chemistry 30	1 - 2" binder, 6 dividers, scientific calculator
ELA 10, 20, and 30	1 - 2" 3-ring binder, 500 sheets of loose leaf, tab dividers
All other subjects	1 - 2" 3-ring binder for each subject. The number of binders will depend on the number of courses to be taken.

Please bring all supplies required on the first day of school, Thursday, September 2, 2025.

A \$30.00 SRC fee will be charged for each student; this helps cover the costs of all SRC-sponsored activities. **Preferred method of payment will be through MySchoolBucks and will be open to accepting payments on August 27, 2025.**

Extracurricular activity participation fee will be determined at a later date.
