Topics

Project Gold Program

- Camp dates and selection criteria released
- Using USSS FFP points list #6 (April 24th) for invitations
- Camps in Utah Olympic Park, Bristol, and Lake Placid
- Coaches can make discretionary requests for promising athletes

National Development Group (NDG)

- New camp-based program for 13-19 year olds
- Targeting 12 athletes to start, focusing on back tucks, back lays, back fulls
- Strict selection criteria to secure funding, with some discretionary spots
- Already identified several eligible male athletes, seeking more female participants

Development Pipeline Strategy

- Project Gold camps feed into larger Project Gold camps
- Project Gold feeds into National Development Group
- Aiming to create a system preparing athletes for 2034 Olympics

Junior Nationals Update

- 50+ registrations already (vs. 50 total last year)
- Using larger freeride jump with 20m landing, allowing double tucks
- Layout: two singles (for potential synchro), hybrid, and mogul jumps
- Tow rope for quick 2-minute turnarounds during training

Eastern Region Aerial Events

- Scheduling conflict between Juniors and Divisional Championships
- Misunderstanding about invitation-only status for some events
- Confusion over A and B aerialist classifications (which don't exist)
- Need for clearer communication and understanding of rules among committee members

Next Steps

- Create and distribute flyer describing aerial opportunities for Junior Nationals participants
- Address Eastern region quota and classification issues in spring meeting



- Submit proposals for championships and divisions by April 15th
- Save-the-date and schedule information for congress coming soon

Action Items

- Create a 1-pager flyer for Junior Nationals. Describe Project Gold, National Development Group opportunities. Including the Scott Kane story. Send to Jack for printing/distribution. Distribute in athlete gift bags at Junior Nationals.
