Susan joined SongBird Survival in January 2021 in the role of CEO, leading the organisation in its aim to see a balanced, healthy and songbird population return across the UK.

In the last two years Susan has led a programme of change, developing a new scientific research strategy, ensuring financial stability and building a programme of engagement and communication campaigns which maximise the impact of the scientific findings.

Susan has a career in the not for profit sector spanning thirty years. She has worked with a wide range of charities; formerly as a charity retail specialist and regional fundraiser, and between 2007 and 2020, as an associate and interim manager with THINK Consulting Solutions, providing advice, market insight and practical tools to help develop fundraising income.



For four years from 2017, Susan was Director of Tony Elischer Foundation, setting up and leading the charity which provides mentoring support and guidance to professional fundraisers in the UK and around the world, helping to develop the next generation of fundraising leaders.

Susan is based in York, and she is also a Trustee of the Psoriasis Association.
