SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

I am applying for: Health Care

Honorably Discharged Veteran Scholarship

INTRODUCTION A scholarship grant may be awarded to a Coal City High School student or graduate based upon demonstrated academic achievement and community service. One may apply for a scholarship in one of Two categories: [1] Health Care/Medical field which can include Emergency Services degrees such as Paramedic/Firefighter, etc. [2] A qualified discharged Veteran who has honorably served in the military, active duty, Reserves or National Guard of the United States of America.

AMOUNT/RENEWAL Each scholarship grant will be in the amount of \$1000. Applicants awarded a scholarship will be notified by the selection committee via U.S. Postal Service. The scholarship is a monetary grant and does not have to be repaid. The student must maintain a 2.8 grade-point average, or the equivalent. Payment will be by check directly to the applicant upon successful completion of a designated semester of study. An official school transcript in the name of the recipient must be submitted to initiate payment. The scholarship grant will be awarded once to student applicants.

CRITERIA: Applicants will submit a completed application, two letters of recommendation, their essay and any other documentation the applicant may deem appropriate to the Coal City VFW Post 1336 or the Coal City High School Scholarship Committee.

Student or Veteran applicants who have elected to pursue a degree or gain certification in Health Care, Physical Therapy, Orthotics, Prosthetics, or a field of study to assist veterans in the future will be highly considered. An applicant who intends to continue his or her education at a trade school, junior college or a four year institution in a general studies program must be a veteran. All applications will be evaluated on appearance, spelling, grammar and the applicant's response to the statements posed for the essay on the application form. Two letters of recommendation are required. One letter is to be written by a school faculty member or district administrator. The other letter may be written by an employer, neighbor, pastor or adult friend. A letter of recommendation submitted by a veteran will be considered significant.

DEADLINE The deadline is the date after which applications will no longer be accepted. The application deadline date for this scholarship is April 7. The application deadline date of April 7 may be varied by the Coal City High School Selection Committee or VFW Post 1336 if there is a sufficient documented reason to do so.
