Unit 1: Classic Tales: *The Wind in the Willows*

Unit Summary Students explore classic tales from different parts of the world, including <i>The Wind in the Willows</i> , <i>Alice in Wonderland</i> , and <i>"Aladdin and the Wonderful Lamp."</i> They study character development, themes, and narrative perspective, and they write text-based opinion paragraphs about characters and themes. Students review significant foundational skills, including short and long vowel sounds, r-controlled vowels, /er/ and its spelling, and syllables with 'le.'
