Craig:

- Calendar under the "trips" button has the other grotto events but shows an error above the calendar "Events from one or more calendars could not be shown here because you do not have the permission to view them." The calendar in the old members section doesn't show the other grotto info.
- General the new site looks much cleaner, you might consider adding a "home" entry to the menu bar at the top (eg, if you click on "news" there is no obvious way back to the home page, click on the header works but is not very apparent. The old blue buttons are still ugly ;-)
- The "members" menu item at the top leads to new stuff, the "members" blue button leads to the old stuff
- In the new members subsections have protected before each name (Protected: News Protected: Information Protected: Calendar Protected: Join Protected: Members)
- Roster seems more up-to-date (actually very up-to-date, although the new members aren't sorted correctly with lastname/firstname reversed)
- The new roster doesn't have a vertical scrollbar (mouse wheel works)
- On the wiki page "</noinclude>" under the disclaimer
- Complex passwords usually just frustration the users with little additional security. Having to guess the username effectively extends the length of the password
