Dear Secretary Gardner and Dep. Secretary Scanlon:

I wrote to you a few weeks back about the lack of consistent absentee ballot information

I received my absentee ballot packet from the town of _____ last week, but was dismayed to see there were NO INSTRUCTIONS included with the package. Because I am familiar with the accommodations that your office made for voters with concerns about COVID-19, I was at least expecting some instructions about how to vote by absentee using the physical disability portion of the signature envelope. Nothing. In fact, no instructions all.

I'm not sure what it was you told the clerks, but this situation must be corrected. Voters should be receiving proper instructions on filling out and returning these ballots, otherwise, these voters run the risk of having their ballots rejected because proper instructions were not given.

Please instruct the town and city clerks on what documents they should be sending out, and please do this immediately, so more voters aren't confused by this.
