Enter on S. 3rd Street.

Paid Events

The UMTAD Mainstage Season and Specialty Series require a purchased ticket to attend.

Free Events

Many of our smaller performances and lectures are free to attend. Usually, we encourage attendees to still make a free reservation.

- Walkups for free events are encouraged, we will fill all available seats, usually beginning 15-30 minutes before the performance.

Please note that for paid performances the box office and Will Call will open 1 hour before the performance.

We will open the theatre for seating when the production team is ready, please be patient as this could be up to 5-15 minutes before the performance.
