

## **Privacy Policy**

Nicholas Pond-Hubert built the Reaction app as a Free app. This SERVICE is provided by Nicholas Pond-Hubert at no cost and is intended for use as is.

This page is used to inform visitors regarding my policies with the collection, use, and disclosure of Personal Information if anyone decided to use my Service.

If you choose to use my Service, then you agree to the collection and use of information in relation to this policy. The Personal Information that I collect is used for providing and improving the Service. I will not use or share your information with anyone except as described in this Privacy Policy.

The terms used in this Privacy Policy have the same meanings as in our Terms and Conditions, which are accessible at Reaction unless otherwise defined in this Privacy Policy.

### **Information Collection and Use**

For a better experience, while using our Service, I may require you to provide us with certain personally identifiable information, including but not limited to Name, email. The information that I request will be retained on your device and is not collected by me in any way.

### **Log Data**

I want to inform you that whenever you use my Service, in a case of an error in the app I collect data and information (through third-party products) on your phone called Log Data. This Log Data may include information such as your device Internet Protocol ("IP") address, device name, operating system version, the configuration of the app when utilizing my Service, the time and date of your use of the Service, and other statistics.

### **Cookies**

Cookies are files with a small amount of data that are commonly used as anonymous unique identifiers. These are sent to your browser from the websites that you visit and are stored on your device's internal memory.

This Service does not use these "cookies" explicitly. However, the app may use third-party code and libraries that use "cookies" to collect information and improve their services. You have the option to either accept or refuse these cookies and know when a cookie is being sent to your device. This policy outlines our stance on objectionable content and abusive users to ensure a positive experience for everyone. By using the App, you agree to abide by these terms. If you do not agree, please refrain from using the App.

#### **1. Objectionable Content**

We do not tolerate any form of objectionable content, including but not limited to:

a. **Hate Speech:** Content that promotes discrimination, hatred, or violence against individuals or groups based on attributes such as race, ethnicity, religion, gender, sexual orientation, disability, etc.

b. Harassment: Engaging in any form of online abuse, intimidation, stalking, or unwelcome conduct that causes distress to others.
