

#### **Jumpstart Dual Enrollment**

Registration for Winter and Spring semester courses on Howard Community College's campus is now open for all students. As a reminder, all students are eligible to take courses on HCC's campus with no tuition or consolidated fee costs (textbook and course fee costs still apply). ### **Counselor's Corner**

#### The 2023 USC Bovard Scholars application is now open!

The <u>USC Bovard Scholars program</u> is a unique opportunity for high-achieving high school juniors with financial need to experience college life firsthand while becoming immersed in an interactive, rigorous curriculum designed to help them get into the college of their dreams. Do you or someone you know fit these requirements?

- Junior in high school (11th grader) at time of application
- Currently hold a 4.0 GPA or above
- Enrolled in Algebra II, Trigonometry or above
- Demonstrate financial need

If so, you are eligible to apply.

If selected, each Bovard Scholar will have one full year of support through the admissions cycle and spend three weeks on the USC campus, where they will receive:

- Personalized career exploration
- Expert admission and financial aid support
- Comprehensive test preparation
- Leadership development

This year, the summer intensive runs from July 10, 2023 through July 29, 2023. We offer the program at no cost to students or families. USC will pay for transportation to and from campus for students coming from outside of Southern California.
