COVID Quick Reference

for parents and students

By sending your child to campus you agree to be responsible for the following:

- Drop off and pick up your child promptly from the designated car park
- Stay away from classrooms (unless escorting a Nursery or Preschool child)
- Send your child to school with everything they need for the day including:
 - A surgical or multi-layer cloth mask without valves and spare mask (except NU, PS, RE)
 - Water and food for break time (tuck shop will be closed)
 - Some school supplies (to reduce sharing)
- Keep your child home when ill and use the responses below
- Any person exiting their car on campus must practice precautions (mask, distance, hygiene)

tests positive for COVID-19	Confirmed	Notify the school COVID group (notify@islzambia.org) Notify the class teacher (primary) or tutor (secondary) Keep your child home for 10 days and monitor for symptoms If symptoms develop, keep your child at home an additional 48 hours after symptoms subside
has been in close contact with a confirmed case of COVID-19 (siblings of close contacts will be treated as contacts)	Close Contact	Notify the school COVID group (notify@islzambia.org) Notify the class teacher (primary) or tutor (secondary) Keep your child home for 10 days and monitor for symptoms If symptoms develop, keep your child at home an additional 48 hours after symptoms subside (not required for individuals with current effective vaccinations).
has an illness that could conceivably be COVID-19	Suspected	Notify the class teacher (primary) or tutor (secondary) Keep your child home while they are unwell and for an extra 48 hours after symptoms subside
has returned to Zambia from abroad (with a negative PCR test as required by the GRZ)	<u>Possible</u>	Notify the class teacher (primary) or tutor (secondary) Keep your child home for 48 hours even without symptoms If symptoms present, proceed as per 'suspected' above

test positive for COVID-19	Close Contact	Notify the school COVID group (notify@islzambia.org) Notify the class teacher (primary) or tutor (secondary) Keep your child home for 10 days and monitor for symptoms If symptoms develop, keep your child at home an additional 48 hours after symptoms subside
have been in close contact with a confirmed case of COVID-19	<u>Possible</u>	Notify the class teacher (primary) or tutor (secondary) Keep your child home for 48 hours even without symptoms If symptoms present, proceed as per 'suspected' under the responses for children above
