HDR support in PNG

Review draft document and outstanding issues:

- Consensus to not require support for YUV 4:4:4
 - PNG does not currently support YUV
 - Complex undertaking that is orthogonal to HDR support
 - Narrow range RGB can be supported without supporting YUV
- Consensus to keep MATCOEFFS signaling for future proofing (PR #17)
- Decoder behavior should be specified when both iCCP and cICP are present
 - Well-defined behavior is beneficial to the web
 - cICP should not always take precedence over iCCP since they apply to different use cases and cICP may contain information not in iCCP

<u>Action Item:</u> Leonard to craft proposal introducing a new chunk containing enhanced ICC information that would take precedence over cICP

HDR in Canvas/WebGPU/WebGL

Chris Cameron has factored out the HDR provisions from the WICG Canvas proposal

Consensus to merge PR #15 after editorial pass by Chris Cameron, using the document as a basis for the work of the CG.

<u>Action item:</u> Chair to file issue on https://github.com/WICG/canvas-color-space indicating that the Color CG offers to study HDR in Canvas, leaving the WICG proposal focused on WCG, which is more mature.

<u>Action item:</u> Chair to encourage participation from Windows (DXGI / DWM), Android and Apple (Simon Fraser) folks to better understand platform capabilities and roadmap.
