Thank you for volunteering! There are a few things you need to do to participate in the summer Wiki project. Important links:

- Introductory Post
- Spreadsheet to Track Progress
- Discord Server to discuss the project
- Current Template
- Grant Post Scheduler Permission

There's a lot of moving parts here, so please help the Wiki/Mod team keep organized!

Claim the post

5 days before your team is scheduled, a post will be made available at https://gamethread.redditcfb.com/miscellaneous_threads.php. These threads will be available on a first come first serve basis, although there's a minimum karma threshold, and the /r/CFB mod and wiki team have final discretion. We'll tend to favor people writing about their own team.

Note that you'll need to grant the post scheduler permission to post from your account. This will only be used for posts you claim through this system (the same as the game thread system). Click the link above to do so.

If you're having trouble with post permissions, there are 2 things that could fix it. First, go to https://flair.redditcfb.com, and make sure it shows your name at the top. If it's signed in as another user (if you have another account) click log out and log back in, or if it's not signed in just log in. Additionally there may be an issue with email verification logging correctly. In this case PM the mod team or let the wiki team know in the discord channel above.

/r/CFB retains no information about you other than your username and account creation date when you grant permission. When you grant permission to use the post scheduler, we receive permission to create posts on your behalf, and will only do so for the posts you have created in the scheduler or game thread system.

Get Wiki Permissions

Ask an /r/CFB moderator to grant you wiki permissions on the wiki page of the team you have claimed. We'll sweep through regularly and do it automatically, but if we haven't after a day please ping us.

Update the Wiki to the Current Template

The template that we'd like Wiki pages to conform to is linked at the top. Try not to delete anything, and some sections are optional. Please rearrange or retitle sections if necessary, and fill in gaps where needed.

Modify the post in the post scheduler

Two things should go in the post getting posted to /r/CFB on the assigned day:

- A subset of what will go in the wiki template, just the following subsections (which you
 may have to write):
 - o 2018 Season
 - o 2019 Preview
- A prompt with questions for the open-ended interview with fans from that team about GameDay experience. This is prepopulated in the template and doesn't need to be touched.

You can optionally invite collaborators to help you edit, just like in a game thread!

Add Responses From Post to Wiki

After your scheduled day, compile the best responses from the post on /r/CFB, and add them into the 2019 Gameday Experience section in the Wiki. Make sure you update your progress in the spreadsheet linked at the top!
