



So no visit to the Royal Muse is possible without seeing the amazing gold state coach. It was built in the 1760s for King George the Third's Coronation.

You're probably not surprised to realize that being such a complicated coach to make, they didn't quite finish it in time, so unfortunately he didn't get to use it for his Coronation. However, it's been used for the Coronation of every King and Queen since then, including our own Queen Elizabeth II back in 1953. So if ever there is an object in the Royal Collection that is more relevant to the Platinum Jubilee celebrations, this is it.
