

Vestavia Hills High School 2025 AP Exam Information

Dear AP Students and Families,

The 2026 Advanced Placement (AP) Exams will take place at Vestavia Hills High School from May 4 - May 15. Morning sessions will begin promptly at 8:00 a.m., and afternoon sessions will begin at 12:00 p.m. Please review the following details carefully to ensure students are fully prepared for testing days.

Testing Locations & Arrival Times

- All AP exams will be administered on campus at VHHS, with the exception of World History (will be administered on campus at VHHS-FC).
- Students receiving accommodations will be contacted via email by Mr. Walker Cook with their testing locations.
- Testing locations will be posted in the Competition Gym and Practice Gym lobbies no later than 7:30 a.m. each day.
- For 8:00 a.m. exams - Arrive at your designated location by 7:45 a.m. Upon completion of the exam, students will have time to eat lunch prior to returning to class.
- For 12:00 p.m. exams - Students will be dismissed at 4A to have time for lunch and to be at their exam by 11:45 a.m.

What to Bring

Depending on your exam format, students should bring the following:

- **Digital Exams:** Fully charged Chromebook with Bluebook installed, College Board login credentials, charging cord, pencils or pens for scratch paper (paper provided by VHHS), approved calculator (for Environmental Science only); (Optional: External corded mouse and/or external power bank)
- **Hybrid Exams:** Fully charged Chromebook with Bluebook installed, College Board login credentials, charging cord, two No. 2 pencils or black/blue ink pens, approved calculator (for Biology, Calculus, Chemistry, Macroeconomics, Microeconomics, Physics, Precalculus, Statistics), ruler or straightedge (for Physics only), (Optional: External corded mouse and/or external power bank)
- **Paper Exams:** Fully charged Chromebook with Bluebook installed (and DAC 2025 necessary for speaking portion of language exams), College Board login credentials, charging cord, two sharpened No. 2 pencils, two pens with black or blue ink; (Optional: External corded mouse and/or external power bank)
- ***If you are taking two exams in one day, be sure to bring a snack, as lunch breaks may be short.***
