Abstract

The abstract and keywords in English must be included in the indicated steps of the submission process. Abstract and keywords **in Portuguese** must be included in the body of the article, after the references. **Abstracts cannot exceed 200 words** and must highlight the main objective, the basic methods adopted, the most relevant results and the main conclusions of the article.

Keywords: 3 to 5 keywords in English must be included.

Section title

Articles must be typed in Word or RTF, Arial or Times New Roman 12 font, respecting the maximum number of words defined by each section, which comprises the body of the text, notes and references. Abstracts are considered separately. **The text must not include any information that allows identification of authorship**; Author data must only be provided in the specific fields of the submission form and in the declaration of authorship.

Images, figures or drawings must be in tiff or jpeg format, with a minimum resolution of 200 dpi, with captions in Arial or Times New Roman 10 font. Tables must be produced in Word. **All illustrations must be included in the body of the article**, but those produced in a format other than Word **must also be sent in separate files**, and will be inserted into the system as "image" or "figure", with respective captions and numbering.

The notes, numbered sequentially in Arabic numerals, must be placed at the end of the text, after the references, in font size 10. **The notes must be exclusively explanatory, written as succinctly as possible.** There are no restrictions on the number of notes.

References

References must follow ABNT standards (**NBR 10520, second edition**). In the body of the text, mention only the author's surname and the year of publication, followed by the page number (if any) in the case of citations. All references cited in the text must appear in the references listed at the end of the article, in alphabetical order. **Authors are responsible for the accuracy of references**, as well as for their correct citation in the text. If using reference management software (e.g.: EndNote), the author(s) must convert references to text.
