I applied to join [Angel Squad](#), an educational program to learn more about early-stage investing, taught by Hustle Fund. Hustle Fund is a pre-seed stage venture capital fund based in Silicon Valley focused on software companies. They were the first investors into companies like Webflow, Nerdwallet, and The Pill Club.

They've built a new type of angel community where angels can invest as little as \$1k into Hustle Fund's top portfolio companies. They review 1000+ companies per month, explain why they are investing in the company, and give members access to their deal flow.

There is a membership fee that allows me to access content, events, and investment opportunities. 1k+ members have gone through it to date. You can learn more about the program [here](#).

Existing members include impressive people from all walks of life – tech execs, unicorn startup founders, professional athletes, doctors, lawyers, chefs, and are located in 50+ countries. The program was designed around people who have full time jobs, and see the program as supplemental to their day to day work. The educational sessions are off-hours and entirely online and do not require travel.
