Website for creating and updating accounts for approval to publish to the Credential Registry <https://apps.credentialengine.org/accounts>. This website, the Credential Registry Accounts System, includes: (1) a page for registering a user profile or logging in to an existing account, (2) a page for creating the organization for which the user is affiliated, and an Account Dashboard to view the organization and user information, invite additional users, and (3) a page for getting permission from and identifying credential organizations allowing third-party publishing and (4) a page for downloading data.

Notes:

This is a website. It is not software and it does not include any electronic documents or authoring tools. The purpose of this website is to create and manage user accounts for organizations to publish information to the Credential Registry. Staff with organizations that will publish data to the Credential Registry use this website to create accounts for the purpose of getting permissions, e.g., API keys, issued to publish to the Credential Registry. The information collected is public information describing the organization (e.g., organization name, description of the organization, address where the organization is located) and minimal information about a user to set up their login (e.g., user name, password, first name, last name, email address).

Evaluation Methods Used:

Conformance to the listed accessibility standards has been evaluated by the technical team members that are responsible for maintenance of the website using analysis tools and manual testing. The following tools were used: [Microsoft Accessibility Insights for Web](#) and [Google Chrome Screen Reader](#). Testing was done using these tools and using a keyboard to ensure all functions are usable without a mouse and to support screen readers. The Microsoft Accessibility Insights for the Web was used to identify any accessibility issues and to address them. This included checking each success criteria in this report manually and in combination with the above listed tools.
