Graduation Update

Before Graduation Day

Rehearsal: Graduation rehearsal will be on Wednesday, May 21st. This will start at 12 and last until about 3. The practice will start with a parade through the lower school, then lunch, then we will start practicing for the ceremony. **This is mandatory for all graduates.**

Tickets: Graduation tickets will be given out at rehearsal. ADA tickets will look slightly different from the general admission tickets.

Graduation Day

Attire: Keep in mind this is a semi-formal event. Wearing jeans, flip flops or sneakers is discouraged. Graduates must wear your cap and gown to participate.

Parking: Graduates, please park in the lower school lot. Everybody else follow the parking lot attendants. Drop off is available for elderly/disabled at the door. <u>Please carpool as much as possible.</u> Handicap parking is available but will be first come first serve.

Arrival: Please plan to arrive no later than 3:00 pm. Seniors should come in through the math hallway exit door. The rooms will be labeled with the first letter of your last name so that you can be lined up alphabetically. Parents will not be allowed to see graduates once they have been dropped off and are in the building.

For guests, the gym doors will open at 3:15 pm. All guests should enter the graduation through the gym doors. Please, don't come in the front door of the building, we will not have the office staffed at that time.

Diplomas: When you receive your diploma sleeve at graduation, it will be empty. Come to the Social Studies hall after graduation to receive your diploma.




